

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of December, the Airfield Crew completed inventory on thirty six (36) lighting packages and one (1) windsock package and shipped all aforementioned containers to Nam Phong. Refurbishing was completed on nine (9) F-17 (earth anchor) packages for storage in the supply warehouse. Repainting and remarking was completed on twelve (12) containers assigned to PAC assets.

ENCLOSURE (1)

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The Maintenance Section performed maintenance on nine (9) retrieve engines, bringing five (5) of the nine (9) to an RFI status. Retrieve Engine 194 was stripped and prepared for shipment to WERS-17 for overhaul. Three (3) absorber assemblies were refurbished, reassembled, functionally tested and brought to an RFI status.

The Service Change Crew installed Service Changes 92, 23, 77, 183, 45 and 140 on Catapult 7405; Service Changes 37, 77 and 183 on Catapult 7406; Service Changes 23, 77 and 183 on Catapult 7408.

The Supply Section prepared and submitted the Mid Year Review Budget with addendum sheet on TBA Deficiencies for Airfields 7405, 7406, 7407 and 7408.

The following gear was shipped from Sub Unit #1 during December:

Thirty six (36) airfield lighting packages and one (1) windsock package to Nam Phong.

One (1) retrieve engine block to WERS-17 at Iwakuni for overhaul.

Two (2) MK-8 Mod-0 Fresnel Lens to SRF Subic for incorporation of Service Change 33.

Four (4) pressure indicators from Catapult Service Change 23 to NAEC Philadelphia for quality control investigation.

One (1) cover from Catapult Service Change 139 to NAEC Philadelphia for quality control investigation.
