1. (U) In accordance with reference (a), the following report is submitted.
2. (U) Operations/Support during the period 1-30 December 1972.

a. Marine Air Control Squadron 4 (MACS-4) continues to support operations in RVN by providing augmentation personnel with the U.S. Seventh Fleet and 621st Tactical Air Control Squadron (TACCS), U.S. Air Force and by operating the Tactical Data Communications Central (TDCC) in Danang.

(1) Air Defense Controllers were provided to Ships of the U.S. Seventh Fleet engaged in combat operations in the Gulf of Tonkin.

(2) One Marine Liaison Officer is attached to the 621st TACCS at Hahnemann Munson MEASB for the month of December.

(3) The TDCC, attached to the 620th TACCS, USARP, continued to perform its mission as the digital data interface between the USARP and USM units engaged in combat operations in RVN.

b. Marine Wing Communications Squadron 18 (MWCS-18) continues to support Task Force Delta by providing both personnel (3 Officers and 52 enlisted) and equipment. The Communications Central, AM/TCG-15, deployed to Cubi Point, Phillipine Islands, continues to provide communications between Task Force Delta and other supporting units at Cubi Point. Supporting the AM/TCG-15 installation are five enlisted Marines.
