### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During this reporting period Marine Air Base Squadron 36 Communication Section performed thirteen Communication Exercises with First Marine Air Wing units at MCAS Iwakuni, Japan utilizing TRC-75 and TSC 15 Van. Communication Exercises with MACS-4 and MASS-2 at MCAS (H) Fatema, Japan were held six times utilizing PRC 77's and TRC 66 systems. The Communication Maintenance Section repaired 305 pieces of equipment during this reporting period.

During the months of January through April Marine Air Base Squadron 36 prepared to mount out for MAFEX 1-75 to MAMBURAO Island, Republic of the Philippines. The mission of Marine Air Base Squadron 36 was to establish a 500 man base camp to support aviation units for the exercise. Marine Air Group 36 involvement in the evacuation of American personnel in South Viet Nam and Cambodia cancelled MAFEX 1-75. During the months of April and May Marine Air Base Squadron 36, supported Operations Eagle Pull and Frequent Wind by detaching two aviators to Marine Light Helicopter Squadron 367 and one aviator to Marine Helicopter Attack Squadron 369. Four radio operators two to each of the above mentioned Squadrons were detached to provide ground radio Communications. The assistant Communications Officer for Marine Air Base Squadron 36 acted as PROVMAG 39 Communications Officer during Operation Frequent Wind.

On 24 June 1975 Carl R. BLEDSOE assumed command of Marine Air Base Squadron 36; ceremonies were conducted in the Marine Air Group 36 Commanding Officer's office.
