## NARRATIVE SUMMARY:

## Air Traffic Control:

Operations for the month totaled 17,584. Operational breakdown by location are as follows: Quang Tri, 10,974, Dong Ha, 4,613, Vandergrift, 1,561. 436 GCA's were conducted at Quang Tri.

The Army assumed Air Traffic Control responsibilities at Quang Tri Airbase and Dong Ha Airbase on 24 and 15 October respectively. ATC facilities terminated on 4 October at Vandergrift Combat Base.
