

PART II - NARRATIVE OF SIGNIFICANT HIGHLIGHTS

On 2 August 1968 Capt DOUGAL led a 2 plane flight on a DAS mission with 1/Lt LAMB as his RIO. He was under the control of JAKE 73 in support of MONGOOSE RUN. The ordnance carried was 10D26's, and 4D5's. The BDA was 6 road cuts, 1 bridge destroyed, and a storage area destroyed.

On 2 August 1968 Capt BERGAN led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission with 1/Lt KELLY as his RIO. He was under the control of RASH 40 in support of JEB STUART III. The ordnance carried was 16D2's, and 4D5's. The BDA was 2 structures destroyed, 4 bunkers destroyed, and 1 secondary explosion.

On 4 August 1968 Maj NOLAN led a 2 plane flight on a DAS mission with 1/Lt PECK as his RIO. He was under the control of CAT KILLER 40 in support of the 3rd MarDiv. The ordnance carried was 13D2's. The BDA was 1 bunker damaged, 1 bunker destroyed, 1 supply dump exposed, 1 artillery position exposed, and 1 communication line cut.

On 8 August 1968 Major HANLEY led a 2 plane flight on a DAS mission with 1/Lt LASHLEE as his RIO. He was under the Control of HOSTAGE-X in support of MAMELUKE THRUST. The ordnance carried was 405's, and 1201A's. The BDA was 4 structures destroyed, 1 structure damaged, 1 rocket propellant secondary fire, 2 other secondary fires, and 1 KBMA.

On 24 August 1968 Major HAMMOND led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission with 1/Lt HALLMARK as his RIO and Captain DANEHY and 1/Lt KELLY in the second aircraft. He was under the control of HELIX II. The ordnance carried was 601A's, 405's, and 709's. The BDA was 21 KBMA(confirmed).

On 25 August 1968 LtCol VERDI led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission with Captain STEINON as his RIO. He was under control of SMITTY R in support of the 9th MARINES. The ordnance carried was 602Y, 405, and 709's. The BDA was 7 bunkers destroyed, 6 secondary explosions, and 3 secondary fires.

On 29 August 1968 the squadron will begin embarkation to Iwakuni, Japan for a period of three to four months in order to retrain its personnel. The main body echelon will embark on 29 August 1968 and the aircraft and all remaining personnel will embark on 1 September 1968.
