NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. During the month of April 1970, VMGR-152 flew 1,487 hours in 582 sorties. Of these, 1,173 hours and 333 sorties were flown in support of the III Marine Amphibious Force in RVN.
- 2. Logistics commitments consisted of airlifting cargo and passengers between Okinawa and Danang; Danang, Cubi Point and Hong Kong; between the various airfields within the I Corps Tactical Zone of operations; and between Futema, Iwakuni and Atsugi. The total number of passengers transported was 11,487; cargo totals for the month show 1,547 tons.
- 3. Night illumination was provided nightly, from sunset to sunrise, for ground forces in the ICTZ by flare configured aircraft from this squadron. There were 63 flare missions flown, dispensing 8,454 flares.
- 4. Aerial refueling was provided for 193 aircraft during the month. This was accomplished on 75 sorties flown as routine on-station tanker missions out of Danang and refueling Marine fighter aircraft supporting the 7th Fleet in BARCAP operations on YANKEE STATION. Also, a total of 1,260,710 pounds of fuel was dispensed during the month's tanker operations.
