

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. (C) During the month of August 1970, Marine Fighter Attack Squadron 122 flew 196 total sorties for 198.9 total hours. This rate was accomplished, as in July, with 12 of 18 assigned aircraft on hand. The type sorties flown included close, direct air support, TPQ radar bombing, combat air patrol, test and ferry flights.
