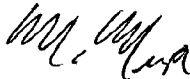

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the reporting period of 1 - 30 September 1970, the "Silver Eagles" of Marine Fighter Attack Squadron 115 flew 336 combat sorties in support of operations throughout the I Corps Area for a total of 330 combat hours.

Significant operations supported by the officers and men of Marine Fighter Attack Squadron 115 included Geneva Park, Frederick Hill, Iron Mountain, Nantucket Beach, Green River, Pennsylvania Square, Elk Canyon, Wolfe Mountain, Imperial Lake, Jefferson Glem, Catawba Falls. Units receiving scheduled or on call air support included the First Marine Division, 101st Airborne, Americal Division, ROK Marines, 1/5 Mech, and ARVN forces.

Bomb damage assessment for the month of September included 1 enemy killed, 42 Bunkers Destroyed, 9 Bunkers Damaged, 15 Structures Destroyed, 8 Structures Damaged, 25 Secondary Explosions, 20 Secondary Fires, 650 Meters of Treeline Destroyed, 1 Road Cut and 110 Meters of Trail Cut.

During this reporting period, Marine Fighter Attack Squadron 115 dropped over 500 tons of ordnance on the insurgent enemy forces. Expended ordnance for the period was 1398 MK-82 Conical Fin 500lb LDGP Bomb, 405 MK 82 Snakeye Fin 500lb Retarded Bomb, 261 Mk-83 Conical Fin 1000lb LDGP Bomb, 268 MK-77 Fire Bomb (Napalm), 8 CBU 24, and 30 CBU MK-20 (Rockeye).

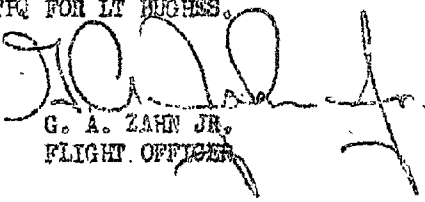

PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the reporting period of 24 - 31 August 1970, the "Silver Eagles" of VMFA-115 flew 71 combat sorties in support of operations throughout the I Corps Area.

Significant operations supported by the Officers and men of VMFA-115 included Geneva Park, Frederick Hill, Iron Mountain, Nantucket Beach, Green River, Texas Star, Pennsylvania Square, Elk Canyon, Chicago Park, Wolfe Mountain, and Imperial Lake. Units receiving scheduled or on call air support included the First Marine Division, 1st Recon Battalion, Americal Division, ROK Marines, and ARVN Forces. These missions consisted entirely of Close Air Support sorties.

Bomb Damage Assessment for the reporting period of 24 - 31 August 1970 included 10 bunkers destroyed, 9 structures destroyed, 8 secondary explosions, 8 secondary fires, and 3 bridges damaged.

During this reporting period, VMFA-115 dropped 205.55 tons of ordnance on the insurgent enemy forces for an average daily tonnage of just over 25 tons. Expended ordnance for the period was 446 MK-82 500 pound bombs, 76 MK-83 1000 pound bombs, and 141 MK-77 500 pound firebombs.

On 24 August 1970, VMFA-115 joined Marine Aircraft Group 11 when LtCol M. MURA led the first flight of three "Silver Eagle" F4B Phantom II's to Danang. The "Silver Eagles" had previously been assigned to Marine Aircraft Group 13 at Chu Lai, Republic of Vietnam.
