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3. Summary of Significant Events

a. Squadron. (U) The squadron rotated from MAG-11, Da Nang AB, RVN, to MAG-15 MCAS Iwakuni on the fifteenth of February 1967.

b. Personnel. (U) One Naval Aviator was transferred to the Third Marine Division. Two Naval Aviators and one Naval Flight Officer were joined from MAG-13. Enlisted strength as increased slightly as compared to the previous month.

c. Awards. (U) Twenty air medals were awarded to flight crew members. Recommendations for fourteen air medals were made to higher authority.

d. Air Operations. (S) During the report period

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recorded 268.4 flight hours and 216 sorties. The squadron flew 264.9 combat flight hours and 211 combat sorties. Missions included TPQ/MSQ, Steel Tigers, Tiger Hound, Helicopter Escorts, Scrambles, Direct Air Support, Landing Zone Preparations, Close Air Support, Tally Ho, Visual Reconnaissance, ADEX, Ferry Hop, and Test. Damage assessment included 12 KBA (C), 66 KBA (P), 161 structures destroyed, 14 structures burnt, 76 structures damaged, 125 meters trenchline destroyed, 3 foxholes destroyed, 5 roads cut, 5 roads damaged, 1 road obliterated, 4 bunkers destroyed, 1 tree canopy opened, 1 gun position destroyed, 4 secondary explosions, and 4 automatic weapons positions destroyed.

e. Training. (U) Weekly Pilot/NFO training was conducted during the month. The squadron completed 116 practice wet and dry Aerial Refuelings utilizing the aircraft of Marine Aerial Refueling Transport Squadron 152. These refuelings were in preparation for the non-stop intra-Theater Rotation of the Squadron to MCAS Iwakuni, Japan.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Marine Fighter Attack Squadron - 115 deployed from DaNang AB, RVN to MCAS, Iwakuni, Japan and reported transfer of Operational Control to MAG-15, 9th, MAB, on 15 February 1967. Squadron aircraft conducted air-to-air refueling over Okinawa utilizing Marine KC-130 aircraft. Embarkation was accomplished using five Air Force C-124 and nine C-130 aircraft, and was completed on 21 February 1967.

The Squadron resumed flight operations at MCAS Iwakuni on 21 February. Initially, operations were curtailed due to adverse weather and the lack of operating TACAN and radar.

Training conducted throughout the period included a weekly Officer/Staff NCO training and orientation period conducted by MAG-15, regular ground training for flight crews, and technical training conducted within the Maintenance Section. Newly joined pilots commenced a cycle of familiarization lectures, and have subsequently completed the flight familiarization phase.

Two Good Conduct Medals were awarded during the period, and six meritorious masts conducted. Six men extended. Savings Bond participation averaged 92.9%.

Aircraft assigned numbered 15, with two in PAR, one in check, and a daily availability of seven. AOCP's averaged 10 per day from 20 - 28 February. Major ground equipment availability was 40%, attributable to routine maintenance and a shortage of parts.
