PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

On 1 and 2 June 1967 VMA-121 flew 52 Combat Sorties in RVN totaling 71.6 hours. Twenty-seven of these sorties were fired upon; however, there were no aircraft hit.


On the night of 2 June 1967 the remainder of VMA-311 arrived to replace VMA-121. On 3 June 1967 VMA-121 commenced movement to MCAS Iwakuni, Japan. The Squadron departed on 3 Air Force C-130's and one C-124. The movement was completed on the 4th of June 1967.

On 8 June normal flight operations commenced. VMA-121 flew another 349 sorties for 496 hours. With exception of a few flights to Atsugi for PAR and Service Changes, these flights were all training type flights. They included FAM hops, Instrument, Tactics and several 30° bomb hops on R-89 (Ashiya Range).

The monthly totals for the Squadron were: 401 sorties accounting for 567.6 flight hours.

During the month of June VMA-121 ferried 4 aircraft to Cubi Pt for Shoehorn modification.
