d. Air Operations. During February the squadron flew 628 sorties, 747.2 hours and dropped 1311 tons of ordnance. Support was provided for the following operations: Scotland, Kentucky, Niagra, Neosho, Flying Dragon (ROK), Lam Son II, Badger Catch (SLF), Osceola, Wallowa/Wheeler (Americal), Eradicate, Lancaster II, Nut Cracker, Jeb Stewart, Houston, Kent, Dinasor, and Saline. Aircrews also bombed targets in the Tally Ho area. The combat sorties were of the following types; Close Air Support, Direct Air Support, Helicopter Escort, TPQ and Landing Zone Prep. BARCAP missions were also flown into Route Packages V and VI in support of Marine EA-6 Aircraft.
