On 3 May Brigadier General Glick toured the squadron flight line. During the tour of the squadron flight line he inspected the A/C that were on the Hot Pad Alert.

PART II - NARRATIVE OF SIGNIFICANT HIGHLIGHTS

During May, Captain BAJAK, USNR, from the office of the Chief of Information for the Navy, was detailed to the squadron filming a movie called "Aircrews". During the time that he was in the area, Captain BAJAK interviewed aircrews; Commander MATTOX who was also working on the same project flew with the aircrews and assisted in the photographic work.

This photography was accomplished with cockpit and wing mounted strike cameras, plus extensive day to day land-bound movie making techniques. The expressed purpose was for ISO release of average Naval Aviators in the combat environments.

On 1 May Captain WOLAN led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of RASH-13 in support of operation Delaware. The ordnance carried was 6D1A's, 4D5's and 7D9's. The BDA was 100/100 1 AA position destroyed, 1 mortar position destroyed, 1 large secondary fire.

On 4 May Major WALDVOGEL led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Finger Print 54 in support of Saline. The ordnance carried was 6D2's, 7D9's and 4D5's. The BDA was 75/100, 3 KBA, 5 fighting holes destroyed and 7 damaged with 1 secondary fire.

On 5 May Major HANLEY led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Finger Print 22 and Kim Chi 8 in support of Kentucky and the ROK's. The ordnance carried was 6D2's, 4D5's and 7D9's. The BDA was 7 KBMA (C), 4 structures destroyed, 2 structures damaged. The flight received moderate fire from the target area.

On 11 May LtCol MONTAGUE led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Cat Killer 46 in support of Kentucky. The ordnance carried was 6Mk87's, 7Mk77's and 750 20MM. The BDA was 2 bunkers destroyed, 2 KBA (C), 50 meters of trench line destroyed.

On 13 May Major BEATTY led a 2 plane flight on a DAS mission in support of Houston under the control of Cowpoke 12. The ordnance carried was 6D1A's, 750 20MM and 7D9's. The BDA was 8 structures destroyed, 4 structures damaged and 10 secondary fires.

On 18 May Captain NOLAN led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Cowpoke 24 in the support of Houston. The ordnance carried was 17D2's and 1500 D20's. The BDA was 8 structures destroyed, 8 structures damaged and 4 bunkers destroyed.

On 19 May Major BEATTY led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Finger Print 33 in the support of Scotland III. The ordnance carried was 18D1A's. The BDA was 20 meters of trench line, 2 bunkers destroyed and 3 fighting holes damaged.

On 19 May Major BEATTY with Captain GUMMINGS as RIO on a CAS mission dropped the bomb that put the squadron over the 10,000th ton of ordnance dropped by the squadron in combat. Since the squadron started flight operations in Vietnam in September 1967, the squadron has dropped an average of 1,167.7 tons of ordnance per month.

On 20 May Captain DECASTRO led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Eilk 21 in the support of Operation Houston. The ordnance carried was 16D2's and 4D7's. The BDA was 3 structures destroyed, 6 bunkers destroyed, 2 KBA and 3 probable KBA.

On 23 May Captain DECASTRO led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Cat Killer 14 in support of the 3rd Marine Division. The ordnance carried was 12D2's and 5D7's. The BDA was 10 meters of trench line destroyed and 10 KBMA (C).

On 25 May Captain CARROLL led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Cat Killer in support of the ARVN. The ordnance carried was 14 D2A's and 14 D7's. BDA was 10 KBMA (P), 10 structures destroyed, and 5 bunkers destroyed.

On 26 May Captain CARROLL led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Southern B in support of operation Kentucky. The ordnance carried was 3D7's and 12D's. The BDA was 6 KBA (C), 1 bunker destroyed and 25 spider holes destroyed.

On 27 May Captain DECASTRO led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Jake 72 in support of operation Wallowa/Wheeler. The ordnance carried was 18D1's. The BDA was 4 KBMA (C), 2 .30 cal. positions and guns destroyed, 1 secondary fire (rocket motors). The flight received fire from the target area.

On 28 May Major NAVIAUX led a 2 plane flight on a CAS mission under the control of Finger Print 33 in support of the 3rd Marine Division. The ordnance carried was 18D1's. The BDA was 5 KBMA (C).

During the month of may the squadron received some new 2.75" rocket warheads that are more lethal then the Zuni warhead. But the squadron has not been able to use them because of the FOD to the aircraft engines when the 2.75" rocket motors are fired.

The squadron presently has one aircraft configured with three (3) MK-4 gun pods. The F4B makes an outstanding gun platform. The squadron is hoping to configure 3 more aircraft with 3 MK-4 gun pods each for use on the Hot Pad. DC-7 was flown four times with the three (3) MK-4 gun pods and fired a total of 6,300 20MM rounds.

During the first part of May the advance party of VMFA-542's pilots and RIO's received local area fam flights with VMFA-122.


