NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During March, WMCR-152 flew 940 sorties. These sorties moved 25,465 passengers and 3673.1 short tons of cargo, baggage and mail. Operations during March consisted of both routine passenger/cargo flights between the Republic of Viet Nam and Okinawa and support of combat operations within Viet Nam. Aerial Refueling doubled over the previous month, from 13 to 26.

Sub Unit 1, VMGR-152, based at Danang A.B., Republic of Viet Nam operated four aircraft in support of in country operations. These operations consisted of aerial delivery, flare drop, aerial refueling, logistial resupply and medical evacuation sorties. The in-country refueling missions increased five-fold over February, the figures being 20 vice 4.
