NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of May, VMGR-152 flew 1,227 sorties for a total of 1,806 flight hours. 35,529 passengers and 5,105 short tons of cargo were transported.

The Sub Unit based at Danang continued to operate with an average of four aircraft. Missions flown consisted of aerial refueling, logistics, and flare drop missions.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Commitments

A review of the commitments flown during May shows the following significant events in chronological order.

- 3 May a. 147572 Crew: Major PIERCE and Captain ONEILL Provided night flare illumination for MEDEVAC for Australian troops in the A Shau Valley.
- 6 May a. 147572 Crew: Captain GARLAND and Major MILLNER While on final approach to a visual landing at An Hoa, aircraft was hit by two rounds small arms fire. One round hit the left horizontal stabilizer, another struck the left wing. Aircraft made an uneventful landing.
- 7 May a. Provided transportation for COL KNAPP from Futema to Danang.
- 11 May a. 148248 Crew: Major SHUMSKY and Captain BURTON Coordinated with Jolly Green Giant helicopters in accomplishing rescue operations near Danang for a downed CH-46 helicopter. All but 6 of the 32 personnel stranded were rescued before the operation was forced to stop due to weather.
- 12 May a. 148248 Crew: Major OCONNOR and Major SMITH Coordinated with 903rd MEDEVAC Squadron in accomplishing emergency MEDEVAC out of Dong Ha, (4 litter critical and 2 ambulatory) after artillery hit division ammo dump.
- 13 May a. 149799 Crew: Major DEORNELLAS and Major DUNLAP Provided flare support for ground troops in direct contact 14 miles Southwest of Dong Ha.
- 13 May a. Provided transportation for BGEN CHIP from Futema to Danang.
- 15 May a. Provided transportation for BGEN CHIP from Quang Tri to Danang.
- 17 May a. 149811 Crew: 1/LT URBAN and Major FRITZLER Provided flare illumination support for emergency helicopter re-supply 1.5 NM West of Khe Sanh and emergency MEDEVAC directly over Khe Sanh.
- 20 May a. 150689 Crew: Major BANKS and Captain JAMES Provided flare illumination support to suppress Viet Cong attacks on Camp EVANS and Camp EAGLE.
- 21 May a. 150689 Crew: Major BANKS and Captain JANES Provided flare illumination support for 2 emergency helicopter MEDEVACS. One at Hill 881 and the other at Hill 689 near Khe Sanh.

- 22 May a. 149804 Crew: Major MNOPE and Major MILLNER Provided flare illumination support near Danang with the Commanding Officers of two Air Force squadronsaboard. They were LTCOL DWIGHT and LTCOL BELSER, based at Naha.
- 22 May b. Provided transportation for COL KELLOGG and COL SHOOK from Futema, Ckinawa to Iwakuni, Japan.
- 22 May c. Provided transportation for CCL VANCE, 1st MAW and COL DRESSIN, Naval Air Electronic System Command, from Danang to Futema.
- 24 May a. 148246 Crew: Major HAYNES and Major MCCAULEY Provided flare illumination assistance for air strikes, helicopter assaults, and ground contact in the vicinity of Danang and Hue Phu Bai.
- 25 May a. Provided transportation for COL SCHMAGLE from Dong Ha to Danang.
- 27 May a. Provided transportation from Danang to Nakom Phanom, Thailand and return for MGEN ANDERSON and BGEN HISE.
- 27 May b. Provided transportation for LGEN CUSHMAN from Danang to Hong Kong.
- 27 May c. 147573 Crew: Captain BURTON and Captain MORTENSEN While on wave-off from An Hoa, 500 meters East of Rwy 06, received three hits. Two utility hydraulic lines punctured requiring aircraft to return to Futema with the gear down.
- 29 May a. Provided transportation for LGEN CUSHEN from Hong Kong to Danang.
