- 1. During the month of December 1969, VMG-152 flew 1,391 hours in 626 sorties. Of these, 1,224 hours and 553 sorties were flown in support of the III Marine amphibious Force in MVM.
- 2. Togistics commitments consisted of airlifting cargo and passengers between Okingwa and Denang; Danang, Cubi Point and Hong Kong; between the various airfields within the I Gorps Tactical Hone of operations; and between Futema, Tuekuni and Atsugi. The total number of passengers transported was 10,094; cargo totals for the month show 2,395 tons.
- 3. Wight illumination was provided nightly, from sunset to sunrise, for ground forces in the TOTE by flare configured circraft from this squadron. There were 56 flare missions flown; 4,211 flares were dispensed.
- 4. Aerial refueling was provided for 302 aircraft during the month. This was accomplished on 92 sorties flown as routine on-station tanker missions out of Dancag, and refueling Marine fighter aircraft supporting the 7th Fleet in BLRGP Operations on YAMMEE STATION. A total of 300,331 gallons of fuel was dispensed during this month's tanker operations.
