#### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. During the month of February 1970, WMGR-152 flew 1,370 hours in 576 sorties. Of these, 1,207 hours and 520 sorties were flown in apport of the III Marine Amphibious Force in RVN.
- 2. Logistics commitments consisted of airlifting cargo and passengers between Okinawa and Danang; Danang, Cubi Point and Hong Kong; between the various airfields within the I Corps Tactical Zone of operations; and between Futema, Iwakuni and Atsugi. The total number of passengers transported was 9,334; cargo totals for the month show 1,895 tons.
- 3. Night illumination was provided nightly, from sunset to sunrise, for ground forces in the ICTZ by flare configured aircraft from this squadron. There were 58 flare missions flown, dispensing 3,692 flares.
- 4. Aerial refueling was provided for 193 aircraft during the month. This was accomplished on 75 sorties flown as routine on-station tanker missions out of Danang and refueling Marine fighter aircraft supporting the 7th Fleet in BARCAP operations on YANKEE STATION. Also, 78 flight hours were flown in support of TRANSPAC KEY WALLOP I & II. A total of 1,270,480 pounds of fuel was dispensed during the month's tanker operations.
