Visitors to Marine Medium Helicopter Squadron 161 during the period 1 to 30 June 1968 were LtGen. HENRY W. BUSE, Commanding General FMFPAC, MGen. NORMAN G. ANDERSON, Commanding General, 1st Marine Aircraft Wing, MGen. CHARLES J. QUILTER, soon to be Commanding General 1st Marine Aircraft Wing, BGen. HOMER S. HILL, Assistant Commander, 1st Marine Aircraft Wing, BGen. HENRY W. HISE, Assistant Commander, 1st Marine Aircraft Wing.

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Marine Medium Helicopter Squadron 161 provided helicopter support for the 3rd Marine Division. Statistics of the support was 22,932 troops passengers carried, 1,906.6 tons of cargo transported, 1101 medical evacuees evacuated, 54 recon teams inserted and 50 teams extracted. This was the result of 2398.8 hours flown, 5,185 tasks and 10,996 sorties. The majority of support went to the Scotland I Phase I, II and III operation.

- 2 June 1968: Commenced Scotland I, phase I, II and III by helo lifting assault troops to Landing Zone Robin.
- 3 June 1968: Lance Corporal W. R. GRUBY while serving as a gunner on a HMM 161 helicopter was responsible for 12 NVA KIA and 2 NVA .50 caliber weapons destroyed while returning enemy fire.
- 4-5 June 1968: Provided helicopter support for 3rd Marine Division.
- 6 June 1968: Lance Corporal W. R. GRUBY added 4 NVA KIA's to his existing 12 for a total of 16 in 3 days while serving as a helicopter gunner.
- 7-11 June 1968: Provided helicopter support for 3rd Marine Division.
- 12-16 June 1968: Provided helicopter support for 3rd Marine Division.
- 19 June 1968: YR 31 crashed in Landing Zone Turkey near the Khe Sanh strip killing the pilot Captain L. S. SHARP, and the co pilot 1stLt. M. D. HELMSTETLER. Crew and passengers were uninjured. Cause of accident is still under investigation.
- 20-24 June 1968: Provided helicopter support for Marine Aircraft Group 39's area of responsibility.
- 25-30 June 1968: Provided helicopter support for Marine Aircraft Group 39's area of responsibility.

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
