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#### PART II

### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of April 1970, HMM-161 continued to fly combat missions in support of the 1st Marine Division, ROKMC and the ARVN units located in the DaNang area. Squadron aircraft and crews accumlated a total of 1,045.9 flight hours while primarily being involved in such tasks as Med-Evac, resupply, troop lifts and strikes, administrative lifts and numerous recon inserts and extracts. In accomplishing these assigned missions, the Squadron flew 3,597 sorties, completing 2,021 tasks, transported a total of 8,260 passengers and delivered 206.6 tons of resupply cargo. The Squadron evacuated 107 emergency, 151 priority, and 160 routine Med-Evacs from field units to medical units in the DaNang complex.

HMM-161 began development of the Starlite System for use by Marine helicopters in night partolling of the "Rocket Belt" to detect enemy rockets and mortars.

The Squadron passed two inspections during the month: an Embarkation Inspection and an A & M Inspection. Also, during the month two individuals received the Navy Commendations Medal with Combat "V".

During the month, the Squadron had one aircraft accident (DEA) and four aircraft incidents with two individuals being injured.
