NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of July 1970, HMM-161 continued to fly combat missions in support of the 1st Marine Division, ROKMC and the ARVN units located in the DaNang area. Squadron aircraft and crews accumulated a total of 1,242.4 flight hours while primarily being involved in such tasks as Med-Evac, resupply, troop lifts and strikes, administrative lifts and numerous recon inserts and extracts. In accomplishing these assigned missions, the Squadron flew 4,433 sorties, completing 2,572 tasks, transported a total of 10,972 passengers and delivered 275.0 tons of resupply cargo. The Squadron evacuated 140 emergency, 116 priority, and 287 routine Med-Evacs from field units to medical units in the DaNang complex.

During the month there were two (2) meritorious promotions for enlisted personnel.

During the month there were ten (10) Air Medals, and six (6) Combat Air Crew Wings awarded to personnel of this Squadron.

During the month, the Squadron had one (1) Aircraft Accident and seven (7) Aircraft Incidents. Injuries sustained by individuals in the Aircraft Incidents were one (1) Minor and one (1) Major and were due to Enemy Fire.
