The flight was briefed at 0735 for the mission. Low clouds over the LZs delayed the flight one hour.

At 0939, 20 HUS-1 helicopters departed Da Nang with 200 troops. A few minutes later the flight split, eleven (11) helos going to LZ 1 (AT955 325) and the remaining nine (9) helos for LZ 2 (AT906 365).

The first division landed in LZ 1 (a ridge line of 2500' elevation) at 1006. Each division followed at 1 minute intervals. T-28s provided close air support. No enemy action was observed.

At LZ 2 the first 6 aircraft landed at 1003 in a rice paddy area. Small arms fire was observed to the right of the second division during the approach. No damage was sustained. The flight joined up with 5-0 taking the lead and returned to Da Nang. The last division was detached. Two (2) helos proceeded to the command post (BT032 344)

The second lift with 17 aircraft and 183 troops landed in LZ 2 at 1100. Deplaning troops and returned to Da Nang.
