- 1 July 1967 Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew two (2) medevac missions today.
- 2 July 1967 Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew five (5) medevac missions today, one (1) of them being a night medevac. Capt SNIDER, while on an emergency night medevac received automatic weapons fire. No hits or injuries occurred. Maj MCDONALD led a flight of four (4) aircraft on an emergency night troop lift to Dong Ha.

- 3 July 1967 Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area today. The squadron flew ten (10) medevac missions.
- 4 July 1967 Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew six (6) medevac missions today, one (1) of them being a night medevac.
- 5 July 1967 Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew five (5) medevac missions today, two (2) of them being night medevacs.
- 6 July 1967 Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew seven (7) medevac missions today. Major CARROLL, while flying day medevac, received automatic weapons fire. There were no hits or injuries.

No injuries occurred.
- ll July 1967 Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew four (4) medevac missions today. Major McDONALD, while climbing out from a medevac, received one (1) round through the transmission deck area. There was no further damage and no injuries.

13 July 1967 - Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew two (2) medevacs today, Major THIEN received light small arms fire twice today while flying admin and logistics missions.

14 July 1967 - Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew twelve (12) medevac missions today, six (6) of them being night medevacs.

15 July 1967 - Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew ten (10) medevac missions today, three (3) of them being night medevacs.

16 July 1967 - Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew four (4) medevac missions today. Capt HUGHES received two (2) rounds through the tail cone section of his aircraft while on an admin run.


22 July 1967 - Normal operations conducted in the Phu Bai area. The squadron flew a total of nine (9) medevac missions




