## B. PART TWO - NARRATIVE SUMMARY

l December 1967 - 5 December 1967 - Normal operations were conducted in the Morthorn I Corps area. HMM-163 supported the 3rd Marine Division by evacuating 173 modevacs in 49 missions, six (6) of which were night missions.

6 December 1967 - HMM-163 supported 3rd MarDiv by evacuating eighteen (18) medevans in 5 missions. Operations were limited due to weather. YP-15, BuNe. 148819, Filoted by Lt. GORDON, was shot down in a zone by automatic weapons and one RPG rocket at YD 152728. The crew spent the night in the zone and picket up the following day. Three crewmembers received Brave injury. The aircraft was destroyed due to area being, inspectivable for receivory operations.

7 December 1967 - 14 December 1967 - Normal operations were conducted in the Northern I Corps area for this period. The squadron flew forty-eight (48) medevas missions, four (4) which were at night, and evacuated ninety-two (92) medevass. Two (2) recon extacts and one (1) recon insert were also flown. Operations were hampered by weather during some of this period.

(15 December 1967 - Normal day operations were conducted int at 2230 quang Tri Air Field was mertared. The squadron evacuated 2 KIA and 40 WIA from the airfield this night. Total medevaes for the day were 6 missions 78 medevaes. Six aircraft were damaged from the attack.

16 December 1967 - 23 December 1967 - Normal operations conducted in the Forthern I Corps area. HMM-163 flow 49 medevas missions evacuating 164 modevas in this period. One (1) recom insert was flown.

24 December 1967 - HMM-163 flew a "Ho Ro" mission today carrying Christess glass to the troops in the finite. These gifts were provided by the squadron, and the Red Gress. Normal operations except for this mission, were conducted in support of the 3rd MarDiv.

25 December 1967 - Operations were limited today to to the Christmas truce. The squadron flew four (4) modevae missions evacuating 18 medevaes. Christmas dinners were flewn to the troops in the field this day.

26 December 1967 - 31 December 1967 - The squadron conducted normal operations in support of 3rd MarDiv. 36 medevas missions, evacuating 103 medevas, were flown in the Serthern I Corps area.
