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PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Aboard the USS NEW ORLEANS during 1-8 January and in support of SLF "Bravo", HMM-164 conducted day and night training and intership administrative flights in the vicinity of DaNang RVN.

Enroute on 8 and 9 January, the squadron subsequently arrived and sent an advance detachment to N.A.S. Cubi Point, Republic of the Philippines, on 10 January 1970. During the period 10-17 January, HMM-164 conducted intensive day and night tactical training flights from N.A.S. Cubi Point.

On 18 January, under the direction of SLF "Bravo", the squadron participated in its third PHIBLEX with BLT 1/9 in the Zambales training area of Navsta, Subic Bay. The Operation concluded on 20 January 1970.

Enroute once again on 21 January, HMM-164 offloaded its entire compliment of aircraft, personell and material at Futema Okinawa on 23 January. The offload constituted the conclusion of the squadrons tour aboard the USS NEW ORLEANS and its operational support of SLF "Bravo" as per noon 24 January 1970.

Subsequently, during 23-31 January it functioned under OPCON of MAG-36, supporting group operational frags as well as continuing training and administrative flights.

On 23 January, Executive Officer Major W. J. SMITH received command of the Marine Detachment at Atsugi, Japan. He was replaced by the present Executive Officer, Major R. O. HARPER.
