NARRATIVE SUMMARY

2 - 3 Nov - HMM-164 participated in Zambales 5-72 in support of ARG "B" and BLT 1/9. The squadron accumulated 77.3 hours of flight time, transported 1741 troops along with 27.8 tons of cargo/artillery weapons. A mix of 2 Ch-46's, 3 Ch-53's, and 2 UH-1E's were used. A total of 183 day field and 136 day carrier landings were executed.

- 4 Nov -- One CH-46 was used as VIP chase for VADM SALZER.
- 7,8, 9 Nov - The squadron supported BLT 1/9 on a training exercise. The BLT was flown into the field and flown out on the final day. During the exercise the squadron also lifted artillery and supplies. Two separate emergency Medevacs were picked up in the field and flown to the Naval Hospital at Cubi Pt.
- 8 - 9 Nov - During this period all three types of squadron aircraft, (UH-1E, CH-46D, CH-53D), test fired the ALE-29 flare dispenser.
- 15 - 16 Nov -- Supporting BLT 1/9 troops in the field, the squadron flew three Medevacs to the Naval Hospital and flew resupply. The troops and their supplies were lifted from the training Landing Zones to the Lower MAU Camp.
- 21 Nov - Four CH-46's flew SAR for suspected man overboard although there was no pickup made.
- 22 Nov - One CH-53 and two CH-46's were used for day carrier qualifications.
- 24 Nov - Two CH-46's delivered by hoist, nineteen passengers and cargo to three ships on the gun line (USS MORTON, USS SCHOFFIELD, USS KEVES).
- 27 -- 28 Nov - HHM-164 aircraft flew LtGen. METZGER, CG, III MAF, to briefings in the DaNang-Hue area, and then returned the general to DaNang.
