PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. LtCol. RAINES' Lady Aces of HMM-165 flew 80.8 hours and 52 sorties during the last 14 days of August, 1969. All working hours were in support of 9th MAB.
2. Logistics commitments consisted of transporting personnel and cargo around the island of Okinawa. The total number of passengers carried were 384 and cargo was 301.8 tons.
3. Mission frags were drawn up as HMM-165 became available for Medevacs, Recons, VIP's, and other miscellaneous flights.
