NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. HMM-165 flew 278.4 hours and 1,026 sorties during the period 8-30 November. All flights were in support of Okinawa based units and Special Landing Force Alfa.
2. Logistics commitments consisted of transporting personnel and cargo throughout the island of Okinawa. The total number of passengers carried was 570, and the total cargo was 32.9 tons.
3. HMM-165 was available for Helosacs, Pocons, VIP's, Riot Reaction, Parachutes, Resupply and other miscellaneous flights. During these operations, HMM-165 carried one Code 5 and 29 Code 7's.
