

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. LTCOL MITCHELL's Lady Aces of HMM-165 flew 809.8 hours and 3475 sorties during the month of February 1970.
2. Logistics commitments consisted of transporting personnel and cargo between ships of SLF B as well as within the Republic of the Philippines. The total number of passengers carried was 1426 and the total cargo was 15.4 short tons.
3. HMM-165 was available for VIP's, MEDEVACS, Riot Reaction, and other miscellaneous flights. During these operations the Lady Aces carried ten Code 7, three Code 6, one Code 5, and one Code 4.
