The month of September 1968 was again very busy for HML-167. HML-167 and VMO-2 continued to work together, with the HML-167 slicks being flown by HML-167 pilots and the HML-167 gunships being flown by both HML-167 and VMO-2 pilots.

During September 1968, the pilots and flight crews of HML-167 flew the varied missions of MedEvac Escort, Recon Inserts and Extracts, Resupply escort, VIP flights, APD missions, visual reconnaissance missions, and the "Fire Fly" searchlight mission.

During the month of September, the pilots and crews achieved 1235.9 total flight hours, of which 691.2 were flown in gunships and 544.7 hours were flown in slicks. In addition, HML-167 aircraft transported 2,586 passengers, flew 3406 sorties accomplishing 823 tasks, and completed 18 MedEvac missions.

HML-167 flew in support of ROKMC Operations DRAGON PALACE III and VICTORY DRAGON II.

The Squadron expended 59,050 rounds of 7.62mm ammunition and 364 2.75 inch rockets in their gunship missions.

22 September 1968 - Marble Mountain Air Facility came under heavy mortar attack. Six (6) HML-167 aircraft received limited damage. With an outstanding effort by HML-167's Maintenance Department, all damaged aircraft were in an up status in less than 24 hours.

29 September 1968 - Three HML-167 aircraft on mission H-17 (APD) received and returned fire at AT852753 and AT834767. VS-22A crashed and burned at AT850635. Alfa damage to the aircraft and 5 personnel were KIA. Four were Squadron flight crew members, and the fifth was a H&MS-16 Airborne Personnel Detector Operator.

September has been another successful month for HML-167. Although still operating under T/O, the squadron was aided by joining 4 pilots. A very envious record was set by our maintenance department of 68.2% availability for the month as compared with 50% availability for all Wing helicopter operations. This is 153.3% aircraft utilization in accordance with standards set by COMNAVAIRPAC. Although still a growing squadron, HML-167 has displayed an excellent "can do" spirit. A high degree of proficiency among squadron personnel and good morale still prevail.
