During the month of October 1968 HML-167 was very active as it began to operate as an independent squadron. HML-167 pilots flew HML-167 slicks and gunships. HML-167 was fraged for her own missions and shared only the night "FireFly" mission with VMO-2.

During October 1968 the pilots of HML-167 flew a variety of missions; including med-evac escort, recon inserts and extracts, resupply escort, APD missions, visual reconnaissance missions, the "FireFly" night illumination mission, and flew an impressive list of visiting General Officers in the execution of the VIP mission. The visiting Generals included General LeMay (retired), LtGen WALT, LtGen BUSE, and LtGen NICKERSON. HML-167 also flew the standard frag VIP missions, transporting CG III MAF, CG 1ST MAW, and CG 2ND ROK Marine Brigade.

During the month of October 1968 the pilots and crews of HML-167 achieved 1287.8 total flight hours, of which 681.1 hours were flown in gunships and 606.7 hours were flown by slicks. In addition, HML-167 aircraft transported 2780 passengers, flew 3707 sorties accomplishing 722 tasks, and completed 10 MedEvac missions.

HML-167 flew in support of ROKMC Operation VICTORY DRAGON III.

The squadron expended 58,000 rounds of 7.62mm ammunition and 491 2.75 inch rockets in their gunship escort role.

5 October 1968 - While working mission H-16 (A resupply out of An Hoa), two HML-167 gunships (6A and 13A) received word that an Air Force F-4 Phantom had gone down on the south side of Charlie Ridge, an extremely hostile area. The flight leader, Captain JEFFRIES, decided to proceed to the scene of the crash to rescue the pilots if possible. While heading into the area of the downed aircraft a parachute was spotted and Captain JEFFRIES was advised by an OV-10A working the area that the downed pilot was receiving fire from his west, and that something would have to be done immediately. After spotting the pilot by having him pop a smoke grenade, Captain JEFFRIES elected to attempt to pick him up. Captain JEFFRIES brought his helicopter to a hover in a small clearing bordered by trees, high grass, and the sides of a small valley that he was in. While hovering and trying to get the downed aviator into the aircraft several bursts of automatic weapons fire was received. As soon as the Crew Chief got a firm hold on the downed aviator the aircraft lifted out of the confined zone as the Crew Chief and Gunner pulled the F-4 pilot into the aircraft. During this pick-up, the second aircraft (13A) was providing cover for 6A.

The four HML-167 Pilots have each received a letter of commendation from Colonel Paul C. WATSON, USAF, Commanding Officer of the rescued pilot.

October has been another successful month for HML-167. The Maintenance Department broke last months impressive record for aircraft availability and set a new 1st Marine Aircraft Wing record. During the month of October HML-167 had an average aircraft availability of 89%. HML-167 also broke a second squadron record for flight hours flown, with 83.1 hours of flight time recorded in one day. For the month of October 1968, HML-167 had 167% aircraft utilization in accordance with standards set by COMNAVAIRPAC. Another outstanding accomplishment was that in 1287.8 flight hours HML-167 Crewed aircraft received no hits from enemy fire. This is attributed to the proficiency and awareness of HML-167 pilots and flight crew members.

The squadron continues with their outstanding "can do" spirit and high level of proficiency and morale.
