The month of November 1968 was a proud one for HML-167. We furnished half of the gunships and all of the UH-1E slicks for the largest Marine helicopter assault in Vietnam, Operation Meade River. HML-167 continued to play the major role in providing gunship escort and command and control slicks for the duration of the operation.

During November a total of 1444.7 flight hours were flown with squadron aircraft which exceeded our previous high by over 100 hours. This included 812.2 hours in gunships and 632.5 hours in slicks. 3227 passengers and 4 medical evacuations were transported. A total of 4622 sorties were completed.

HML-167 gunships expended 92,550 rounds of 7.62 ammunition and 1381 2.75 FFAR's in their role of transport escorts. Two aircraft were forced to land because of battle damage, but were recovered. One of these aircraft received substantial damage while the other one was flying again the next day.

One aircraft had an engine failure while over hostile terrain, but the pilot made a skillful landing into the best available landing zone. The crew was rescued and the aircraft recovered while under small arms attack from a hostile unit.

One squadron pilot sustained a bullet wound in the leg which caused him to be evacuated out of country.

Besides Meade River, HML-167 participated in special operations Victory Dragon III and Victory Dragon V. Our normal missions of firefly, transport escort, VIP, APD, visual reconnaissance, reconnaissance inserts and extracts, and light transport were accomplished concurrently.

November has been another highly successful month for a still growing squadron. Our high availability of 81% for the month was accomplished only through the outstanding efforts of our maintenance department working countless manhours. Morale is high and HML-167 has attained the reputation of a "can do" squadron.
