The month of January was a challenging one for Marine Light Helicopter Squadron 167. Confronted with adverse weather and its associated hazards, the officers and men of HML-167 were ready when called upon and responded by performing the missions with the professionalism that has become the squadron's trade mark. The squadron "guns" provided "on-station" fire suppression for Medical Evacuations, Reconnaissance Inserts and Extracts, and Resupply Missions. The Squadron "slicks" aided Marine Ground Commanders by providing Command and Control Aircraft, performing visual reconnaissance, and flying the Airborne Personnel Detector mission. The Squadron VIP commitment saw HML-167 providing helicopter transportation for such notable visitors to Vietnam as General Leonard P. CHAPMAN Jr., Commandant of the Marine Corps, and Lieutenant General H. W. BUSE Jr., Commanding General, Fleet Marine Force, Pacific.

Some of the airlift and suppression statistics compiled by HML-167's "Finest" during the first month of the New Year were as follows; 1551.7 total hours of flight time, of which the "slicks" flew; 885.1, and the "guns" 666.6. There were 3623 passengers carried by this squadron during the month, and while usually engaged in a role as "gun cover" for the more conventional medical evacuation aircraft HML-167 also made 4 medical evacuations. A total of 4875 sorties were flown while accomplishing 1119 tasks.

HML-167 provided helicopter support for the following operations: "Taylor Common", "Linn River", "Victory Dragon VI, VII" and "Sold Mariner".

January 1969 saw a new addition to the Squadron's offensive capabilities in the Helicopter Trap Weapon (HTW), a landing zone improvement device. The weapon is a modified Mini continuous rod warhead which deploys a parachute to orientate the warhead vertically prior to impact. The weapon is used to clear prospective Landing Zones of elephant grass, brush, booby traps and other hazards to landing. The HTW represents the first attempt to bomb from helicopters, and it is significant that the first combat drop in history was made on 21 January 1969 by Lieutenant Colonel Thomas P. MILLER, HML-167's Commander while flying TV-5, UN-1E BuNo 152418.
