NARRATIVE SUMMARYPART II

The month of April was the busiest yet for HML-167. The Squadron was called upon for 1709.2 hours of flight time. Flying in support of III MAF, 1st MARDIV, and the ROKMC the Squadron flew 5078 sorties, accomplished 857 tasks, and carried 3548 passengers.

Squadron gunships flew 796.9 hours. HML-167 guns delivered 1538 rounds of 2.75 inch FFAR and 50,100 rounds of 7.62 mm in the accomplishment of their various missions. Typical gunship missions provided armed helicopter escort for CH-46's performing reconnaissance inserts and extracts, med-evacs, and resupply. The Squadron also provided armed escort for the Airborne Personnel Detector missions.

Squadron slicks were even busier, amassing 912.3 hours of flight time. Typical slick missions provided transportation for VIP's, airborne personnel detector. Notable among the VIP's carried in April were Lieutenant General BUSE, Commanding General, Fleet Marine Force Pacific and Lieutenant General NICKERSON, Commanding General III Marine Amphibious Force.

The Squadron flew in support of Operations "Victory Dragon IX", "Victory Dragon X", and "Oklahoma Hills". A total of 17.60 tons of ordnance were dropped on the enemy in these operations by HML-167 in April.

In summation, April was a fine month for HML-167. The Squadron has continued to live up to its title of "MAG-16's Finest". The professionalism and "can do" spirit of all in the Squadron point toward even better months ahead.
