NARRATIVE SUMMARY

PART II

After two successive record breaking months HML-167's total flight hours fell off somewhat for the month of June. The reduction was due primarily to a parts shortage combined with the acquisition of seven additional UH-1B's without a corresponding increase in personnel. Although the squadron now has a total of 31 aircraft assigned, it has accepted the additional workload and is meeting this new challenge with the traditional HML-167 "Can Do" spirit.

The flight statistics still show an impressive 1542.1 hours of total time. Squadron Gunships flew 845.7 hours and Squadron Slicks flew the remaining 696.4. A total of 5021 sorties and 632 tasks were completed.

HML-167's Gunships expended 74,000 rounds of 7.62 and 600 rockets in the accomplishment of their missions. This expenditure of ordnance can be attributed to the relatively light enemy contact in Operation PIPESTONE CANYON. Recently the ground units have been moving casualties to secure areas for Med-Evac, this has also contributed to less enemy contact.

Squadron slicks were busy carrying 2255 passengers in June. HML was honored to have transported Ambassador and Mrs. BUNKER, Lieutenant General BUSE, CG, FMFPac, and Lieutenant General NICKERSON, CG, III MAF, also enjoyed the services of HML-167 Slicks.

June may be considered a month of consolidation after so many months of record breaking performances. The Squadron looks forward to July and many more months of outstanding performance.
