



NARRATIVE SUMMARY

PART II

Although faced with a qualified pilot and crew shortage and low aircraft availability during the first portion of the month the determination of this squadron to overcome all obstacles prevailed and all commitments were fully met. The HAL-167 maintenance department put forth another outstanding performance and was able to substantially increase availability by the end of the month. Qualified pilot availability improved greatly over the entire period due to the enthusiasm and aggressiveness of our "new guys" and the professionalism of our "old hands".

Increased emphasis was devoted to all phases of VIP missions leading to improvement in the squadrons capability to perform this important task. The goal of the squadron is to provide the most "squared away" crew and aircraft possible for every VIP flight. To achieve this the squadron has worked day and night to dress up our UH-lE "Slicks". In line with this pilots and crews received additional training in the technique and conduct of VIP missions.

Although the number of VIP, C&C, and administative missions increased the squadron continued to fly a high number of armed helicopter escort missions. These missions included medevac, resupply, reconnaissance and quick reaction guns. The versatility and skill of its personnel continued to allow the squadron to successfully meet its commitments.

Pilot training this month was increased by the use of guest speakers at each All Officer's Meeting. Speakers included the MAG-16 Intelligence Officer and the Lycoming Engine Technical Representative.

Flight statistics for September are as follows: squadron slicks flew 765.5 hours and the gunships compiled 550.3 hours for a total of 1315.8 hours. Also 4067 sorties and 492 tasks were completed. The gunships delivered 46,600 rounds of 7.62 ammunition, 109 high explosive 2.75 rockets, and 84 white phosphorus 2.75 rockets.

During the month of September, Checker Board slicks carried 2608 passengers. Among them were Lieutenant General BUSE (CG, FMFPac), Lieutenant General NICKERSON (CG, III MAF), Lieutenant General LEE SAE HO (CG, ROK Forces in Vietnam), and Ambassador KIM (Korean Ambassador to Vietnam).

Six new officers idined the squadron this month. They were Majors J. S. MARTIN, R. J. THRASH and Lieutenants S. R. BOULTON, R. M. DODD, G. D. LEAMING and L. M. THRASHER. The checkmates also welcomed 24 enlisted men. These personnel helped replace the 3 officers and 17 enlisted men who returned to CONUS this month.

Although in the last few months, the majority of experienced pilots have left HML-167, the squadron has not suffered. Those who remain, mostly "new guys", are highly qualified, talented, and aggressive. They are now the "hackers", and are determined to carry on in the tradition that has enabled HML-167 to claim the distinction as truly being MAG-16's Finest.


