The month of October was one of excellence for HML-167. Improved pilot and crew availability and an increase in the number of "UP" aircraft enabled the squadron to assume more missions in addition to the regular C&C and gunship missions. Pilot and crew expertise and professionalism have been recognized by members of other squadrons in MAG-16.

Pilot skill has been enhanced by a pilot training program which includes lectures at AO's on flight related subjects by knowledgeable individuals. Guest speakers for the month included the Bell Helicopter Company technical representative who gave a presentation on UH-1E vibrations, the Operations Officer of MATCU-68 whose subject was air control in the Danang/Marble Mountain area, and a combat experienced OV-10 pilot who discussed in detail the technique of aerial observation. Another result of HML-167's intensive training program has been the qualification of eight pilots this month as pilot-in-command. Strict adherence to the NATOPS Flight Manual and a highly emphasized safety program have also contributed to the professional attitude that comprise pilots pride themselves with.

Flight statistics for October are as follows: squadron slicks flew 881.3 hours and the gunships compiled 520.4 hours for a total of 1401.7 hours. Also 4214 sorties and 535 tasks were completed. The gunships delivered 64,200 rounds of 7.62 ammunition, 336 high explosive 2.75 rockets, 147 white phosphorus 2.75 rockets, and 72 Helicopter Trap Weapons.

During the month of October, Checkerboard slicks carried 3001 passengers. Among them were General ABRAMS (COMUSMACV), Lieutenant General BUSE (CG, FFPac), Lieutenant General NICKERSON (CG, III MAF), and Lieutenant General LEE SAE HO (CG, ROK Forces in Vietnam).

Four new officers joined the squadron this month. They were Lieutenants L. E. CASNER, R. N. DUEMLING, J. L. HUTTON and W. W. NORTH. The checkmates also welcomed eighteen enlisted men. These personnel helped replace the two officers and twenty-two enlisted men who returned to CONUS this month.

Due to the rapid progress of its new pilots in qualifying as pilot-in-command and the stepped up maintenance effort the F-167 "Checkmates" expect to continue to uphold the claim of being MAG-16's Finest.
