NARRATIVE SUMMARY

PART II

One of the more significant events occurring during the month of November took place on the 8th when LtCol J. E. WEBER, Jr., assumed command of HML-167, accepting the squadron colors from LtCol J. W. LASETER.

Due to normal rotation and transfers, the command structure of the squadron was again adjusted this month. Major ANDREWS was transferred to 1stMAW as Safety Officer and Major SHARR became HML-167's Operations Officer. Major MARTIN became Maintenance Officer while Lt BALLATO relieve Lt COLE as Intelligence Officer.

Along with the arrival of LtCol WEBER as our new C.O., the squadron welcomed aboard four new "Checkmates"; Lieutenants SMITH, HOGUE, GRANDY, and OLSHESKI. Five pilots completed their in-country check-out and moved over to the right seat, giving the squadron twenty-five pilots in command. Of seven enlisted personnel dropped from the squadron, only two replacements were acquired. With the losses brought about by the twelve vice thirteen month tour, the squadron has found itself putting in many long days with maximum effort put forth to accomplish the assigned missions and tasks. Our aircraft availability was maintained at a high average of 72.6 percent. This can be attributed almost directly to the above mentioned efforts of the maintenance department. It is unfortunate that we must anticipate a drop in availability due to the programed loss of twenty-three more of our maintenance personnel in December without like replacements.

On 25 November, Major General THRASH, CG, 1stMAW, paid the officers of HML-167 a visit, giving a short brief on our mission and the role we play as part of the 1stMAW. He also entertained ideas and suggestions on possible ways to improve on any problem areas we may be encountering in the accomplishment of our assigned mission.

Flight statistics (page 6, para 4) saw slight improvement over those of last month.

Among the 3240 passengers our "Checker Board" aircraft were such notables as General WALT (Assistant Commandant of the Marine Corps), Mr. FRIEDHEIM (Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense), Lieutenant General ED PIERSON (US Air Force Assistant to Chairman Joint Chief of Staff), and Brigadier General BLANCHARD (US Army Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense).
