PART II

January was an even more eventful and busy month than December 1969. This is substantiated by the fact that we flew 2466 hours for the month, a new high for the "Checkmates" of HML-167. The new record was made possible because we had a daily average of 26 aircraft available and all hands; pilots, crew, and mechanics, worked many long, hard hours.

We are still plagued by a shortage of UH-1E qualified maintenance personnel but the increase in flight time over the month of December is indicative of the increasing experience level of our mechanics. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the maintenance and aircraft availability picture for the month of February will be even brighter.

The month was unusual in that only one Department Head was changed. 1st Lieutenant R. L. HERRINGTON was assigned as the Intelligence Officer when 1st Lieutenant N. J. BALLATO completed his tour and returned to CONUS. Nine pilots left the squadron for various reasons. 1st Lts. DORROH and CRAWFORD were medevaced for wounds. 1st Lt. HOGUE dislocated a knee while running to man his aircraft for an emergency medevac. The knee was injured severely enough to justify his being medevaced. An ironic way to have a tour cut short. The other six pilots either returned to CONUS on normal rotation or were reassigned within the Wing. Thirteen new pilots joined the squadron during the month. Four were normal additions and nine are CH-53 experienced copilots who will have to be trained in the way of the UH-1E. Seven pilots were moved to the right seat during the month, giving us now a total of 40 qualified pilots in command. On the face of it, this seems a large number but when it's considered that we have 38 aircraft, the number assumes its true proportion. The nine CH-53 co-pilots we have received as a result of the redeployment of HMM-361, are most welcome and will start flying early in February upon completion of UH-1E ground school.

Good weather during January contributed significantly to our total flight time. We flew under 50 hours only two days of the month, under 75 hours only 12 days, and we were over 100 hours five times.

We lost no aircraft this month although enemy action and operational incidents/accidents laid up seven aircraft for damage extending from minor to substantial. 1st Lieutenant E. H. DAVIS experienced an engine failure at about 2000 on the evening of 17 January. He shot a successful autorotation to the surfline on the beach about 3 miles NNW of Marble Mountain.

The UH-1E is repairable but it was a bedraggled looking bird on its return to the HML-167 flight line. An estimated 1,000 pounds of sand was removed from its bilges before repairs could be started. The sand made an impressive pile on the ramp beneath the frazzled UH-1E.

Numerous VIP's were transported in HML-167 "Slicks" during the month but our "VIP-of-the-month" was General CHAPMAN, Commandant United States Marine Corps, while he visited RVN. He visited HML-167 on the morning of 9 January and chatted informally with all hands who weren't flying.

The first month of the first year of the 70s opened with a record number of flight hours flown and HML-167 will busily continue to live up to its motto "MAG-16's finest".


