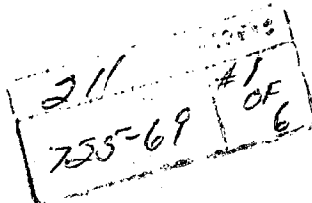

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. All operations during the reporting period 01 through 30 November were conducted from Chu Lai Air Base, Republic of South Vietnam.
2. During the month of November the squadron flew 383 combat sorties for 471.3 combat hours while delivering 564.9 tons of ordnance on enemy positions and in support of operations listed in Part III, Paragraph 2.
3. Our new hanger is now supplied with electricity and only needs a few finishing touches before we move in.
4. The average availability for the morning launch during November was 16 aircraft for 78.5% of A1 aircraft.
