## NARRATIVE SUMMARY (S)

- 1. (U) During December, VMA-211 continued to conduct combat operations from Bien Hoa AB, Republic of Vietnam.
- 2. (U) Of 967.1 hours flown in December, 761 sorties for 937.7 hours were flown on CAS/DAS missions in MR II, MR III, and MRIV, Republic of Vietnam and in the Khmer Republic. There were no combat sorties flown on 25 December.
- 3. (U) Enemy activity directed toward Bien Hoa AB consisted of five attacks by fire. On 1, 4 and 15 December and twice on 16 December, the base received small volleys of incoming 122 and 107 MM rockets. No damage or casualties were suffered by VMA-211.
