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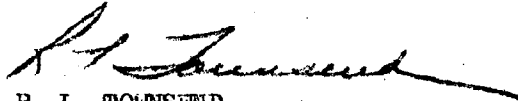

PART II - Narrative Summary

1. The month of April, the squadron's second full month of operations in the Republic of South Vietnam, has been a very productive month. The squadron flew 388 missions while delivering 2140 tons of ordnance on targets in South Vietnam and Laos.

2. Well earned promotions were granted to 15 Marine enlisted personnel, and several men received Meritorious Basts for their outstanding efforts toward the achievement of squadron objectives.

3. As the month ended, the novelty of the new surroundings had been replaced by awareness and experience which will help us continue to operate in the efficient and productive manner in which we have begun our tour.

PART III - Significant Events

1. Personnel

a. During the month of April the squadron finished its final phase of Operation Mixmaster and transferred and joined 4 men from CONUS and transferred 3 men while hospitalized to Okinawa and Guam, 2 of which returned; 1 officer and 1 enlisted. Three men were transferred back to CONUS and the squadron Admin Chief was transferred to MABS-11.

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2. Administration

a. On 6 April one man was accidentally killed due to negligence and as a result of this the man involved is awaiting trial by General Court-Martial for murder. This mishap involved many reports, inventories, condolence letters, and investigations.

b. During the middle of the month the squadron had another accidental discharge of a weapon and as a result of this the 2 men involved were given a Summary Court-Martial and reduced in grade. Two men were also reduced at Office Hours for misconduct.

c. The squadron had 1 man promoted to PFC; 2 men promoted to LCpl; 4 men promoted to Cpl; 3 men promoted to Sgt; 4 men promoted to SSgt; 1 man promoted to GySgt.

d. There were 2 men who extended their overseas tours and 1 man who cancelled his overseas extension. Two approvals are pending for extensions overseas.

e. Thirty-two men were awarded the PUC for their efforts on their first tour in RVN.

f. The S-1 office became custodian of all office supplies for the squadron thereby relieving the S-4 section of this duty.

g. The intense work load has subsided somewhat in the past month due to new control boards and the clerks getting familiar with their new environment plus a better understanding of the numerous reports required by the Group S-1.

a. Lance Corporal Glenn W. THOMAS 2369338/6316 USMC, died 6 April 1969 of a wound received by accidental weapon discharge.

11. Materiel

✓ a. Logistics. There were no significant shortages during the reporting period. The DaNang Bomb Dump explosions curtailed all logistic support and squadron operations for approximately 11 hours (1030-2130). A new M-715 truck was assigned for the primary use of Materiel and S-1.

b. Materiel. Two augmentation personnel were assigned to perform the function of day and night expeditor. The arrival of a new ditto machine, mimeograph machine, and adding machines has alleviated the shortage of labor saving devices within the squadron. The post reinspection of the Marine Corps Property Account was satisfactory with very minor discrepancies. The assignment of a new vehicle has greatly reduced a long overdue problem of transportation connected with all functions of the Materiel Unit (e.g. Police Sergeant, Buildings and Grounds, Marine Corps Property, Public Works at China Beach, Salvage, etc.).

c. Motor Transport. Our carlist vehicles were turned in and new M-715 trucks were issued as replacements. The squadron has 2 each of the new M-715 trucks with the expectation of receiving one more in the near future.

d. Embarkation. Mount-out box lids were utilized upon arrival at DaNang to build temporary desks, shelves, and other emergency use until furniture arrived from Chu Lai. This has caused a shortage of 200 lids for Navy Property mount-out boxes. A work order request has been submitted for replacements. No significant problem areas have been uncovered this reporting period.

✓ e. Buildings and Grounds. Thirty new bunks and mattresses were received and distributed. Bunkers in the living area were repaired with 3 being completely rebuilt. All enlisted huts were rewired. Little or no damage was experienced from the bomb dump explosions. The hangar suffered the most serious damage; one support beam buckled at the southwest corner. Most of the hanging light fixtures and doors were repaired the following day (27 April).
