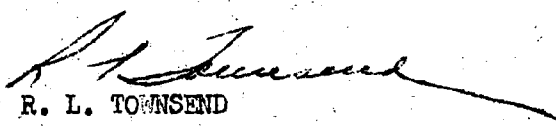

1. The month of May, the squadron's third full month of operations in the Republic of South Vietnam, has been a very productive month. The squadron flew 406 missions while delivering 2199 tons of ordnance on targets in South Vietnam and Laos.

2. Well earned promotions were awarded 13 Marine enlisted personnel, and several men received Meritorious Masts for their outstanding efforts toward the achievement of Squadron objectives.

3. The squadron was saddened by the loss of one of its men who was killed in the line of duty by an enemy rocket. Another man received minor wounds from the same incident. A Memorial service was attended by many of the Officers and men of the squadron.

- a. Logistics. Maintenance support is declining due to the shortage of critical aeronautical parts. A pylon assembly ordered on 24 February has

not yet arrived. Status from ASO indicated that the delivery date would be 9136. When the pylon didn't arrive on schedule, a supply assistance request was sent. A new expected delivery date has not yet been established at this time. Three aircraft are AOCF for fuel cells. One cell was received from MAG-11 Group Supply in a non-rfi condition. Three more aircraft are AOCF for hydraulic motors. At the present time we have 23 AOCF's outstanding against 3 aircraft.

b. Materiel. Materiel is in the process of purifying all the squadron's outstanding documents. Response on priority 05 requisitions will be improved in the near future.

c. Motor Transport. The use of the new M-715 vehicles has helped the transportation situation by greatly reducing preventative maintenance and out of commission time.

d. Embarkation. MEDS cards were revised to conform with the new materiel code listing published by FMFPAC and the deck was submitted to Wing for approval and audit. Sgt KUEHN attended Embarkation school in Okinawa from 28 April through 23 May, and finished third in his class. The present squadron SOP for Embarkation, 4600.1, is in the process of being replaced. The new directive will conform to all current FMFPAC Embarkation Orders.

d. Buildings and Grounds. Available screen was used to replace damaged window screen in several huts in the enlisted area. Enough additional screen was ordered to replace all the screens on the enlisted huts. Also work requests have been initiated to construct awnings on all huts, to prevent rain from saturating bedding and personal effects, and to install ceiling fans in all the enlisted huts.
