PART II - Narrative Summary

1. The Squadron completed its 5th month of combat operations with the continued success it has enjoyed from the onset. 374 combat sorties were flown in 488.8 flight hours while delivering 2117 tons of ordnance on targets in South Vietnam and Laos.

2. On June 21, LtCol R. L. TOWNSEND relinquished his command to LtCol D. L. HARVEY, one aircrew member left for FAC duty, and two aircrew members were assigned Group duties, four aircrews were joined from CONUS. All changes were completed in an extremely smooth manner with no loss of continuity.

3. The squadron was recommended by Group for the Meritorious Unit Commendation for services rendered from 1 Aug 1968 to 15 June 1969.

7. Aviation Safety

There were no accidents or incidents during the month of June.

8. Materiel

a. Logistics. Capt CHIPMAN checked in this month relieving Capt SHEPHERD as Logistics Officer. The shortage of critical items of supply is still hampering the maintenance effort somewhat. The pylon assembly ordered in February has not yet been received although we have shipping status. All of the fuel cells reported in last months report have arrived so there is no longer a problem in that area. Last month all aircraft were ANFE for ALE-18 gaskets. This was cut to four during June. At present we have 22 AACP's against 4 aircraft, 14 ANFE's against 9 aircraft and 101-777 requisitions outstanding.

b. Materiel. A combined annual inventory of equipage and change of commanding officer inventory was held during this month. There has been a marked improvement in the processing of routine documents by group supply during the month due to rewarehousing in progress.

c. Motor Transport. A 5000 gallon refueler trailer M131A4D was surveyed during the reporting month. We received a new trailer in its place. The M-715 vehicles are posing no maintenance problems as yet, which has been a definite asset to the transportation situation.

d. Embarkation. A meeting was held the first of the month by Group Embarkation to discuss the vast number of changes to the MEDS systems. A lecture on the semi-annual Embarkation Report was also given. This report is due on the 10th of July and at this time is very near completion. 1st Lt J. P. WELLS was replaced by 1st Lt W. R. TEGLIA, who is currently undergoing OJT in this field.

e. Buildings and Grounds. New wash rack have been erected in the troops living area during June. Most of the damage caused by the Bomb Dump Explosions has been repaired. Improvements to the living areas and the hanger are being made as material becomes available.
