PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Through the month of November, VMA(AW)-225 continued its mission of attacking and destroying surface targets under all weather conditions. The squadron flew a total of 361 sorties dropping a total of 1,569 tons of bombs. This resulted in a BDA of 7 bunkers destroyed, 200 meters tree line and 90 meters trench line destroyed, 80 secondary explosions, 42 secondary fires and 18 trucks damaged/destroyed. Further BDA included one structure destroyed and one trail cut.

The squadron resumed the flying of Commando Bolt and Armed Reconnaissance missions in support of the Seventh Air Force in Laos. VMA(AW)-225 is currently scheduling 7 AR/CB's nightly which has proved quite successful in the interdiction of enemy vehicular resupply routes. Of the squadron's total monthly BDA, these missions accounted for 18 trucks destroyed/damaged, 38 secondary fires and 68 secondary explosions.

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Poor weather was in abundance throughout November as Typhoon Patsy hit the DaNang area on 8 November causing heavy rains and flooding. Overcast skies dominated the weather scene the remainder of the month but proved only a minor hindrance to squadron flight operations. Utilization of the RABFAC beacon enabled VMA(AW)-225 aircraft to provide all weather close air support to Marine and Army ground units during this entire period.

The evaluation of RABFAC beacon "Buddy-Bombing" was completed during November and results were tabulated and sent to Wing Headquarters recommending official approval. In the meantime, authorization to continue Buddy-Bombing was granted. Aircraft from VMA-311 (A-4E's) and VMFA-115 (F-4B's) flew wing on squadron A-6A's throughout November's monsoons to exploit this concept to the fullest extent. Squadron aircraft that lacked full systems were also utilized in this capacity, thereby increasing the squadron's ordnance delivery capability under all weather conditions.

VMA(AW)-225 had several visits by V.I.P.'s during November. The Assistant Commandant of the Marine Corps, General Louis B. WALT, delivered a message at the H&NS-11 hangar on 4 November with squadron personnel attending. Later, the Assistant Commandant was briefed on the RABFAC beacon and "Buddy-Bombing" procedures by the squadron. On the 6th, Rear Admiral R. E. RIERA toured the squadron area; Colonel W. E. MEINZEN, U.S.A., observed squadron facilities on the 12th; and Major General A. H. ADAMS, USMC, visited VMA(AW)-225 on the 23rd.

Several improvements were effected in the Buildings and Grounds department. The enlisted recreation hut was painted and the pool table inside was refurbished. Four hot water heaters were installed providing hot showers for both staff and enlisted. Over 100 feet of new walkway was constructed in the enlisted living area and repairs were completed on the roofs of 6 hootches damaged during the typhoons in October. In addition, painting of the enlisted and staff showers and heads was begun.

1. Endorsements to reference (a), authorized an evaluation of "Buddy-Bombing" utilizing the A6A all weather attack capability and ordnance delivered by A4/F4 airplanes flying wing on an A6A. Results of the evaluation and recommendations are contained herein.

2. A total of 13 missions have been flown using A4/F4 and A-6 airplanes as Buddy-bombers. A table of sorties flown by mission number is included as Enclosure (1). The evaluation was conducted during daylight, night and instrument flight conditions. The RAPAC beacon system was utilized during the evaluation giving the A6A the all weather close air support capability.

3. A detailed brief was conducted with all aircraft involved prior to each flight and flight parameters were agreed upon. Bombing runs were accomplished either shortly after take off or in the target area as briefed. Once in formation the A6A controlled the flight and called for the wingman to release their ordnance using the standard TPQ terminology: "Stand-By, Stand-By NODR, NODR".

4. During the first flights of the evaluation an attempt was made to determine if any significant impact errors were induced as a result of the time delay between the A6A's call for release and the wingman's reaction time. This was done by making several runs alternating releases from the A6A and the airplane flying wing on the same target using the same computer data. An estimated range error of 300 feet long was observed by the ground FAC. This error was compensated for by inserting 300 feet release advance into the computer. Subsequent impacts were on target and this correction seemed to be valid for the flight parameters of 300 kts TAS and 10,000 ft used during the evaluation.

5. The wingman's ordnance was delivered using the same technique as the train release using intercommitter switching technique in their previous operations. No difficulty was experienced using either type of release.

6. The A-1A "Buddy-Bombing" evaluation results indicate that ordnance delivery from F-4, F-4 and A-1A flying wing on a single engine A-1A is an extremely effective and accurate means of providing the ground forces with on-call weather close air support capability. It further significantly increases the amount of ordnance that can be delivered during adverse weather conditions.

7. It is recommended that A-1A "Buddy-Bombing" be authorized as Standard Operating Procedure and that the recommended procedures provided as Enclosure (8) be approved and published.

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8. The buddy bomber(s) will release their ordnance either in salvo or "sticks" depending upon the requests of the FAC and the airplanes capability.

9. The release velocities of the airplanes involved are compatible and the correction generated by the A6A ballistic computer is correct. A negative release advance of 150 feet is required when dropping bombs from the zero-20 stations of the A-1. A release advance of 300 feet is required to compensate for the wingman's reaction delay time when delivering from 10,000 feet AGL and 300 kts TAS. If the above flight parameters are not used a spotting bomb will be dropped from the buddy bomber and the necessary adjustments will be made by using release advance.

10. The lead aircrew on any buddy bombing mission will be fully qualified to fly these missions in accordance with the criteria established by Marine Aircraft Group 11, First Marine Aircraft Wing.

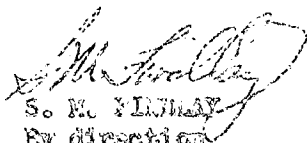
