PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Through the month of December, VMA(AW)-225 continued its missions of attacking and destroying surface targets under all weather conditions. The squadron flew a total of 399 sorties dropping a total of 1,738 tons of ordnance. This resulted in a BDA of 8 bunkers destroyed, 5 structures destroyed, 149 secondary explosions and 40 secondary fires. Commando Bolt missions into Laos accounted for 62 vehicles destroyed or damaged during the month. Additional BDA includes 200 meters treeline destroyed, 30 trail cuts, and 3 road cuts.

With the arrival of a developmental team from CONUS, the evaluation of the new LASER guided bomb began during December. Although this weapon is compatible with all attack aircraft, it will be employed by the A-6A in conjunction with the RAEFAC beacon. This concept involves an aircraft systems drop to get the bomb well within the necessary parameters for the LASER to

take over terminal guidance. An all weather capability is thusly introduced as long as the ceiling does not go below 4,000 feet AGL (a limitation on the LASER gear itself). Evaluation is scheduled for completion on 31 January 1971.

Of significance in the safety annals of VMA(AW)-225 is the fact that the squadron did not have any aircraft accidents/incidents and zero ground accidents during the month. This marks the first month in fiscal year 1971 that this has been achieved.

The squadron had one VIP visitor during December. Lt. Gen. Donn J. ROBERTSON, USMC, was given a briefing on 29 December on the mission and avionics system of the A-6A.

The Christmas day cease-fire had only a minor effect on squadron operations since out of country missions continued during this period. Better than half of the squadron's missions are Commando Bolt flights into Laos. The Armed Reconnaissance missions were discontinued during December due to their relative ineffectiveness.

December brought two new Majors to VMA(AW)-225. Maj. J. G. GOWART relieved Maj. G. A. DAVIS as Executive Officer, and Maj. J. P. FAULKNER replaced Maj. G. W. BURKLEY as Operations Officer.

Several Buildings and Grounds projects were completed in December. These included the painting of the outside of the showers in the enlisted living area, one hundred feet of new walkways, and the construction of two armories. The armory that was built in the living area also has a weapons cleaning area. Furthermore, work was begun on a TV and reading hut and two new comfort stations (heads) in the enlisted living area.
