PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of March, WMA(AW)225 continued its missions of attacking and destroying surface targets under all weather conditions. In establishing new records for total hours, combat hours, and sorties flown, the Squadron completed 683.5 hours, 672.2 of which were combat hours, and flew 453 combat sorties. Over 1990 tons of ordnance was dropped resulting in BDA of: 7 bunkers destroyed, 3 structures destroyed, 1 structure damaged, 279 secondary explosions, 96 secondary fires, 300 meters of treeline destroyed, 20 meters road/trail cuts, 51 trucks destroyed, 1 bulldozer destroyed, 1 weapon destroyed, 1 weapon damaged, 2 gun positions destroyed, and 1 ford destroyed.

On March 19 three surface to air missiles were fired at Ringneck 456 as the aircraft was climbing off target after completing a CAS(AW) mission approximately 5 NM south of the DMZ. The crew took evasive action and observed airbursts two thousand feet above and behind the aircraft.

From 22 March to 26 March the Squadron was inspected for redeployment readiness. Results are not available at this time.
