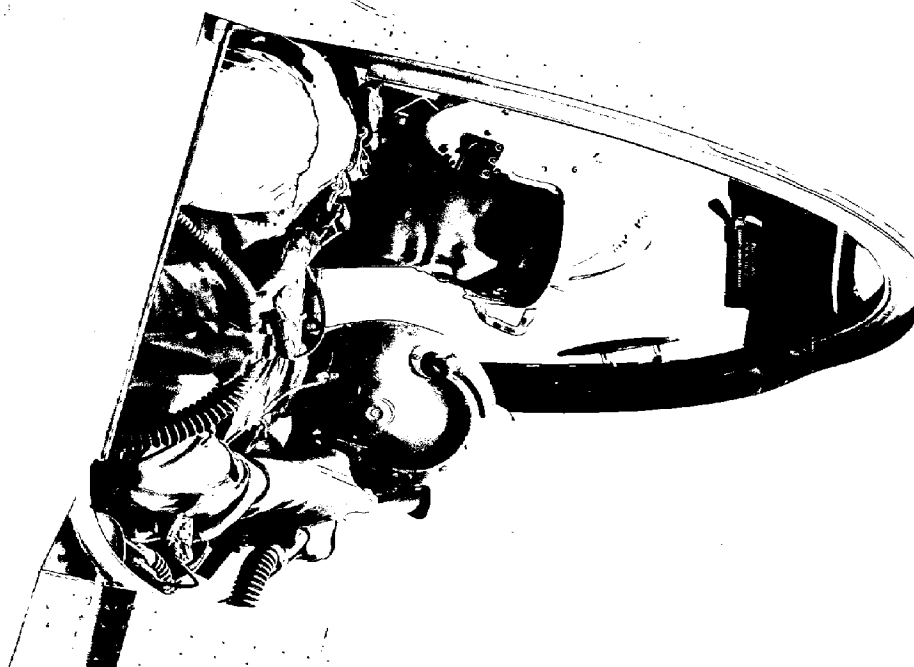

b. Significant problem areas directly relating to NORS percentage:

(1) During the month of June 107 NORS/G requisitions were initiated in addition to 14 unfilled NORS/G requisitions brought forward from the previous months. Of the 121 NORS/G requisitions for June, 108 were completed. The average time required to complete each NORS/G requisition was 77.2 hours. This represents an excess of supply reaction time.

(2) During the month of June 123 NORS/N requisitions were initiated and 47 unfilled NORS/N requisitions were brought forward from previous months. Of the 170 NORS/N requisitions only 137 were completed. NORS/N requisitions outstanding from previous months represent 37.8% of total outstanding NORS/N requisitions. This supply reaction time is also excessive.

Subj: Logistics Summary Report (Logsum)

3. Significant problem areas directly relating to NORM percentage:

a. The excessive NORM is primarily attributed to the downed WHEEL components. During this reporting period an average of 95 WHEEL components were inducted into IMA each day. This results in at least 3 aircraft continually NORM at all times. Until all aircraft are WHEEL equipped, NORM will remain proportionally high.
