4. Visitors to the Command. On 1 November, LtGen Herman NICKERSON, JR. visited VMA(AW)-242 and discussed personnel problems with the Commanding Officer of VMA(AW)-242. On 20 November congressman MCGADE from the 10th District of Pennsylvania visited the MAG-11 area.

PART II - Narrative Summary

With the bombing halt that went into effect on the evening of 1 November, VMA(AW)-242 substantially reduced the scope of its air operations. For ten days, VMA(AW)-242 flew TPQ's almost exclusively. A limited number of Beacon flights were also flown. On the night of 11 November, VMA(AW)-242 was scheduled to begin striking a target in Laos and later in the month a second target was added. Due to AAA activity in the target area, Marine F4's from MAG-11 were scheduled to fly in trail of the A-6A's as flak suppression. These flights met with limited

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success because of weather and visibility problems.

BDA for the month of November was light primarily due to the nature of the targets in Laos and the fact that only TPG's were flown at the beginning of the month.

PART III - Significant Events

1. Personnel. During the month, five officers and twenty-four enlisted personnel were transferred. Six officers and four enlisted personnel were promoted.
2. Administration. The annual audit of Service Records continued through the month of November and will be completed by 20 December 1968. The audit had to be temporarily discontinued due to the large number of personnel who were rotated during November instead of their normal rotation in December.
3. Casualties. None.
4. Morale/Welfare Program. Four marines participated in the out-of-country R&R program while four enlisted personnel participated in the in-country R&R program.
5. Career Advisory. Two marines requested six month extensions overseas which were forwarded recommending approval while one staff non-commissioned officer extended his enlistment for one year. There were ten preliminary reenlistment interviews conducted by the squadron Executive Officer.
6. Education. Thirty education interviews were conducted. There were seven USAFI and two MCI enrollments this month. Three examinations for course completions and one diploma were received.
7. Passports and Visas. One visa application was processed and received.
8. Bonds. The overall average participation in the U. S. Savings Bond program was 73% with a high of 84% and a low of 64%.
9. TIO. There were thirty-two fleet home town news releases processed this month.
10. Civic Action. One officer and one staff non-commissioned officer attended the Wing Civil Affairs Personnel Response School to better acquaint the squadron with the First Marine Aircraft Wing civic action program.

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11. Awards. During November, thirty-one air medals were earned by twenty-four crewmembers.

12. Air Operations. During November, VMA(AW)-242 flew 302 sorties for 367.2 hours and expended 1645.360 tons of ordnance. The squadron launched 125 full system sorties with 107 full systems up over target for an average of 85.6%. There were four missions flown over North Vietnam. All of the missions in Laos were strike missions in support of the 7th Air Force while the missions in North Vietnam were armed reconnaissance and seeding missions in support of the 7th Air Force.

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d. Aircraft Dispersal. On the night of 17 November, one aircrew diverted to Ubon, Thailand during a rocket attack on Danang A.B.. They returned the following morning. On the night of 24 November, two aircrews diverted to Ubon, Thailand during a rocket attack on Danang A.B.. They returned the next morning.

15. Aviation Safety. During November, three no damage mishaps occurred. A MK-82 bomb failed to release on an ordnance run but fell off on the runway when the aircraft landed. This mishap occurred due to a malfunctioning multiple ejector rack. In the second mishap, one engine experienced a flame-out when the throttle linkage became disconnected. The third incident was a flame-out that occurred when the fuel boost test switch remained engaged and the throttle was reduced to idle at a high altitude.

16. Special Operations. Squadron flight operations took a radical change during the month of November following the announcement of the bombing halt on 1 November. For the first ten days of November the Squadron flew TPQ's and a few beacon hops. Beginning the night of 11 November, VMA(AW)-242 was scheduled to strike one target in Laos. A second target in the immediate proximity of the first was also scheduled shortly thereafter. Both of these targets were choke points in the highway leading from the Mu Gia pass to central Laos. The two choke points were hit eight times each night by VMA(AW)-242 with a variety of ordnance. During the early flights, considerable AAA fire was encountered. As a result F4 type aircraft from MAG-11 followed in trail in an attempt to strike the gun positions that were firing against the A6A aircraft. Due to weather and the short period of time the AAA was firing at the A6A, successful tracking runs were next to impossible. While it remains doubtful if any guns were destroyed by the F4's, AAA fire incidents in the target area were reduced to near zero during the latter part of the month. The F4 flights were discontinued on 23 November. Since that time only very sporadic fire has been received.

There was a considerable reduction in flight operations during the month of November due to the fact that there were no scheduled CAS/DAS flights, a minimum of beacon flights and a reduction in TPQ's. The majority of TPQ's were write-ins at the request of the squadron for crew check out purposes.

Attempts were made at running the beacon with an A6A and two F4's (one on each wing of the A6A). The "Mini ArcLight", as this operation is called, has had minimal success to this point. As in the past when using the beacon, communications and coordination with the controlling agencies were the most significant factors for a disappointing performance. As a result of the switch in Sace vans to 310 Series, plus a large turn over in the maintenance department, squadron availability experienced a marked reduction during the month.

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17. Basic Training. During the month of November, basic training lectures were held for newly assigned personnel. Training was also held for individuals on the use and FAM firing of various weapons.

18. Logistics. See Appendix "C".

19. Motor Transport. The average availability for November was 97.9% for the eight vehicles assigned.

20. Maintenance. DT-01, BuNo 149950, has been inventoried and readied for final processing to be barged to PAR at NAS Norfolk. There continues to be a critical shortage of shop supervisors. One man was promoted to Corporal and one man was promoted to Lance Corporal in the Maintenance Department this month.

21. Avionics. One hundred twenty-five full system launches were accomplished with one hundred seven systems up over target. This shows a reliability of 85.5% systems over target.

1. In accordance with references (a), (b), (c), and (d) the following report is submitted:

a. Aircraft Status:

(1) Of 12 A6A assigned a 51.9% NORA rate is due to the following reasons:

BUNOS 149950, 152596, and 152597 were down for scheduled maintenance.

b. Critical Items:

One - 2RQ 1560-800-2606 PA7X Aircraft Canopy
 Two - 9Z 5330-831-6563 Boss Seal

c. Significant Problem Areas:

(1) The availability of the MMR 7-527 Adapter Kits has been unsatisfactory. These kits are urgently needed to repair existing MMR 7-527's to ensure that an adequate number of MMR Bomb Racks are available to meet squadron commitments.

(2) The MMR weapons cradles in use by this squadron have deteriorated to unsatisfactory levels due to a shortage of replacement parts. Initial ordering of these parts occurred in February 1968. This item was a continuing subject in this report until October 1968 when a reorder was initiated. The reorder has proven as unfruitful as the initial order. At present 468 parts for 31 cradles are on order.

(3) The drainage system in the VMA(A-1) 242 Hangar has been unsatisfactory since the road in front of the hangar was resurfaced. Work request No. M-11-40-69 was submitted on 25 July 1968 to relieve this situation. Public Works estimators talked to the squadron members concerned during September 1968. No further action has been taken.

(4) The revetments damaged during the 27 July Rocket attack have not been adequately repaired. These revetments have rocket and bomb holes in the sides causing the fill to leak out. The roofs have not been replaced nor have the damaged roofs been repaired. It is requested that the revetments needing earth fill be filled as soon as possible to ensure adequate safeguarding of the parked aircraft.

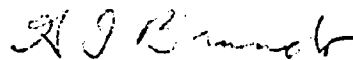
