4. Visitors to the Command. During February Maj. General C. J. QUILTER, Commander 1stMAW visited the Squadron area.PART II - Narrative Summary

1. During the month of February there was a large increase in beacon sorties flown. The squadron daily frag was changed to 2 GAS, 5 beacon, three A/R and two TPQ's. In March this will be increased to include 13 hours per day hot pad every third week. Systems availability has shown an increase due to the addition of two aircraft and better maintenance. Beacon hops continue to give some good BDA. On 23 Feb the hangar and fuel pits took direct hits from enemy rockets resulting in one killed in action and two wounded. There were no aircraft damaged and alternate fuel pits are being utilized.

PART III - Significant Events

1. Personnel. Seven Officers and ten enlisted personnel were joined during the month. Three officers and nine enlisted personnel were transferred. One officer and five enlisted personnel were promoted. The squadron reached 70% participation in the Savings Bond Program during the month.

2. Administration: The pages of the Officers Qualification Record and Enlisted Service Record book were rearranged and social security numbers were entered above service numbers so all pages are in compliance with the Individual Records and Accounting Manual, MCO P1070.8, which becomes effective 1 March 1969, for all commands located in WestPac.

3. Casualties:

(1) Lance Corporal Thomas B. STEVENSON, JR, 2228484/6371, USMC, was killed in action, at approximately 0530, on 23 February 1969. Lance Corporal STEVENSON was performing his duties as a support equipment machanic when the VMA(AW)-242 hangar sustained a direct hit from enemy rocket fire. He was killed instantaneously by schrapnel. A memorial service was held in the Danang Chapel at 1500 on 26 February 1969.

(2) Private First Class Peter C. PASSALUNGA, 2282238/6316, USMC, and Lance Corporal Ciriaco VARGAS, 2358359/6351, USMC, received burns and were medivaced to the 12th Air Force Hospital at Cam Ranh Bay. Private PASSALUNGA's condition and prognosis were excellent. Lance Corporal VARGAS's condition was satisfactory and his prognosis was good.

4. Morale/welfare: Thirteen Marines participated in the Out of Country R&R program and two Marines participated in the In-Country R&R program. Two Marines took annual leave.

5. Career Planning: Four Marines were granted three month extensions and one was granted a six month extension. One Staff non-commissioned officer re-enlisted for four years. One reserve officer augmented into the regular Marine Corps. Five career planning interviews were conducted.

6. Education: Nine education interviews were conducted and one Marine enrolled in a USAFI course.

7. Passports and Visas: One passport was renewed and one visa applied for.

8. Bonds: The overall average was 66% with a low of 64% and a high of 70%.

9. TIO: There were no home town news releases processed this month.

10. Awards: 35 Air Medals were earned by 28 NA/NFO's during the month.

11. Air Operations: During February, VMA(AW)-242 flew ³⁷¹~~319~~ sorties for 400.6 hours, expending 2053.296 tons of ordnance. The squadron launched 114 full systems sorties with 75 full systems up over target for an average of 66.7%.

d. Aircraft Dispersal: On 18 February one aircraft diverted to Ubon, Thailand due to weather. The aircraft returned to Danang the same day.

12. Aviation Safety: The command had one no damage incident when an ejector rack and MK-82 bomb separated from a MER in flight. The cause was a failure to install retaining bolts during overhaul.

13. Special Operations: During February the squadron picked up additional beacon hops on the frag. As a result the squadron

continued to get some good BDA. Capt QUaid and Capt STONELL presented briefings on the A6A/FAC Beacon concept of operations to the Air Force, Americal Division and various Special Forces Camps throughout I Corps. These Special Forces Camps now have the FAC Beacon and A6A's have began working with them.

14. Basic Training: Indoctrination lectures were conducted for all new officers and enlisted personnel. Crew training was conducted weekly emphasizing system self check operations. Two tests were taken by air crewmembers during the month to ensure NATOPS review.

15. Logistics: See Appendix "C"

16. Motor Transport: The average availability in February for eight vehicles assigned was 96.9%.

17. Maintenance: VMA(AW)-242 averaged 8.2 aircraft availability per day with a NORM time of 1535 hours for 27.4%. The NORS time was 288 hours for 5.2%. The squadron flew 400.6 hours with 986.2 scheduled maintenance hours and 548.8 unscheduled for a 130.1% utilization. The squadron launched 114 full system hops with 75 over target and 68 at landing. There were 64 partial systems launches, 67 over target and 71 at landing. The average sortie length was 1.2 hours. VMA(AW)-242 dropped 2053.296 tons of ordnance during February.

1. In accordance with references (a), (b), (c) and (d), the following report is submitted:

a. Aircraft Status

(1) Of 14 A-1A aircraft assigned a 27.6% NORM rate is due to the following reasons:

FWNO 152934 was down for maintenance on the aft fuel cell, and BUNCS 151571 and 152623 were down for completion of acceptance checks.

b. Critical Items

(1) Pre-expended Bin Items

c. Significant Problem Areas

(1) Pre-expended bin items have not been updated since 15 Jan 69. Priority 5 comments for replenishment of these PEB items are not being filled, resulting in a priority 2 overload.

(2) Again this reporting period, Ground Support Equipment is our main problem area. Garwood tractors are the items needed most. Two hours is the standard waiting time to move an aircraft from revetment to radar dock where all our systems maintenance must be done. The problem has reached such proportion that this squadron has had to resort to use a borrowed air force tractor to maintain the work load.

As stated before, all systems maintenance must be done in the radar docks at this time. This is due to the fact that the squadron has only one

NR-10 air conditioner unit which is essential while performing maintenance on computers, inertial systems, and radars. Access to another NR-10 unit would enable 35% - 45% of the radar dock workload to be completed in the revetments. This in turn would alleviate the garwood situation to some degree.

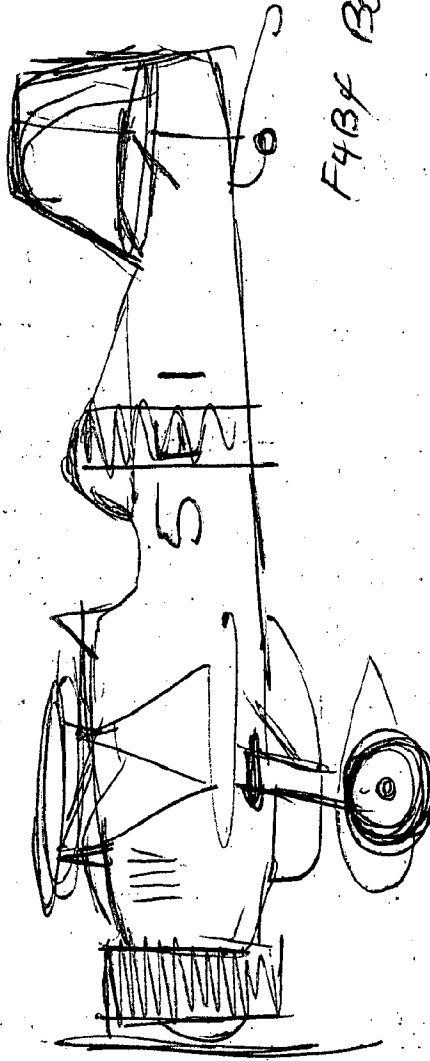
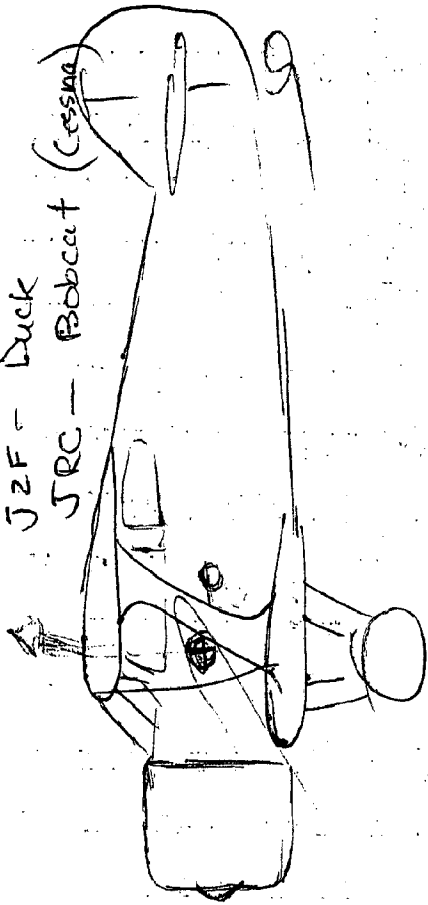
