4. Visitors to the Command. On 20 March, LtGen H. W. BUSE Jr., Commanding General, Fleet Marine Force, Pacific visited the squadron hangar area for an A6A display and a brief on A6A systems.

PART II - Narrative Summary

1. The squadron's frag continued about the same as it was during the latter part of February. Due to an increase in both airframes and systems availability, the squadron was able to continuously make the frag plus fulfill a large percentage of "write-ins" requested by Group Operations. The beacon hot pad was also used extensively. This increase in sorties flown has resulted in the squadron logging the most flight hours since March 1968. BDA continues to show an improvement which is mostly due to the enthusiastic receipt and confidence shown in the FAC beacon by the infantry.

PART III - Significant Events

1. Personnel. Five Officer and fourteen enlisted personnel were joined during the month. One officer and two enlisted personnel were transferred during the month. The squadron reached 70% participation in the Savings Bond Program during the month.
2. Administration. Beginning 1 March 1969 the Marine Corps Manpower Management System (MMS) of unit diary reporting was begun.
3. Casualties. Lance Corporal Ciriaco VARGAS, 2358359/6351, USMC was returned to duty on 14 March 1969 and the award of a Purple Heart Medal has been approved for presentation. Lance Corporal VARGAS received burns during the rocket attack of 23 February 1969.
4. Morale/Welfare. Fourteen Marines participated in the out-of-country R&R program and six Marines participated in the in-country R&R program.
5. Career Planning. One Marine was granted a six month in-country extension. Two career planning interviews were conducted.
6. Education. Six education interviews were conducted and three enrolled in correspondence courses. Two men were administered GED tests and three MCI final examinations were given.
7. Passports and visas. One passport was renewed.
8. Bonds. Four Marines started bond allotments.
9. TIO. There were 61 home town news releases processed this month.
10. Awards. 33 Air Medals were earned by 27 NA/NFO's during the month.
11. Air Operations. During March, VMA(AW)-242 flew 406 sorties for 521.2 hours, expending 2,146.461 tons of ordnance. The squadron launched 246 full systems sorties with 175 complete systems up over target for an average of 71.1%.

d. Aircraft Dispersal: During March the squadron had two (2) in country and five out of country divers. One (1) A/C diverted to Phu Cat, one (1) A/C diverted to Chu Lai. Four (4) A/C diverted to Ubon and one (1) A/C diverted to Udorn. All A/C returned the same or following day.

12. Aviation Safety: During March two no damage mishaps occurred; a loss of combined hydraulic system pressure was due to an improperly installed isolation valve, and a hung bomb fell from a multiple ejector rack on the runway after landing. The causes were undetermined. No trends noted.

13. Special Operations. The squadron continued to show an increase in FAC Beacon hops. More beacons were issued during March and are now being used for the first time in Northern I Corps. At present FAC Beacons are being used by the 1st Marine Division, 3rd Marine Division, ROK Marines and two (2) Special Forces Camps.

14. Basic Training. Indoctrination lectures were conducted for all new officers and enlisted personnel. Crew training was conducted by Grumman Technical Representatives on A/C systems. The Tech Reps also held ground school for Avionics personnel.

15. Logistics. See Appendix "C".

16. Motor Transport. The average availability in March for eight (8) vehicles assigned was 96.7%.

17. Maintenance. VMA(AW)-242 averaged 10.5 A/C availability per day with a NORM time of 2365.4 hours for 30.1%. The NORS time was 505.0 hours for 6.4%. The squadron flew 521.2 hours with 766.0 scheduled maintenance hours and 1599.4 unscheduled for a 132.2% utilization. The squadron launched 246 full systems with 175 up over target and 151 at landing. There were 23 partial systems launches, 37 over target and 46 at landing. The average sorties length was 1.3 hours. VMA(AW)242 dropped 2,146.461 tons of ordnance during March.

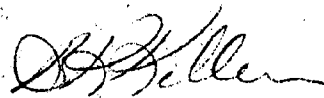

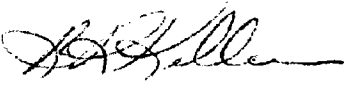
