PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

HMM-262 Supported the following operations during the month of June 1968:  
 Operations SCOTLAND II, KENTUCKY, LANCASTER II, and NAPOLEON/SALINE.

Operation Scotland II was the most active and required the greatest support from HMM-262. This operation alone accounted for more than 1,000 flight hours for the month of June. In flying for Operation SCOTLAND II, HMM-262 lifted better than 9,000 troops, 1,100 tons of cargo, for a total of about 5,000 sorties. Besides resupply and troop lift missions, HMM-262 also contributed to numerous successful med-evac missions.

During the month of June, HMM-262 also supplemented VMO-6 missions by providing one OH-46 "gunship" to assist in escorting convoys from Khe Sanh to LZ Stud. The HMM-262 Armory devised and built a mount so that two additional .50-caliber machine guns can safely be utilized for special missions such as convoy escort.

Operation Lancaster II was the second largest Operation supported by HMM-262 accounting for about 130 flight hours. HMM-262 carried over 34 tons of cargo and 2,750 passengers for a total of over 600 sorties in support of this operation.

The third largest Operation for HMM-262 was Operation Kentucky. Support of this Operation consisted mainly of troop lifts, a total of 2,200 troops. Re-supply consisted of about 20 tons of cargo for a total of about 100 flight hours.

Operation Napoleon/Saline accounted for the least of HMM-262 commitments. The squadron logged 40 hours carrying 700 troops and 9 tons of cargo for a total of of 150 sorties, in support of this operation.

In addition to these operations, HMM-262 also provided one aircraft for the 3RD Marine Division Courier Run. The route followed by this run went from Quang Tri, to Dong Ha, to Phu Bai and to several landing zones in the Da Nang area. This commitment accounted for three to six hours of flight time per-day.

Operations were conducted with few interruptions due to the good weather and decrease in enemy attacks on Quang Tri and Base.

HMM-262 flew a total of 1743.9 flight hours during the month of June, with an average of ~~35.8~~ flight hours per aircraft Commander.

#### OPERATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

1 June 1968 Upon being diverted from his re-supply mission 106, Maj David L. ALTHOFF flew an emergency med-evac mission in support of Grasshopper "E". Although weather was deteriorating and Huey gunships were not available, Maj ALTHOFF successfully evacuated 5 emergency and 5 priority med-evacs from Grasshopper "E"'s position. The pick-up zone was extremely hot due to incoming mortars; but no damage to the aircraft was sustained.

- 6 June 1968 A HMM-262 flight of eight aircraft, under the leadership of MAJ H. E. BRITT successfully lifted 3/9 from XD902332 to XD-982226. HMM-262 received a personal "Thank You" from BGEN HILL for a job well done. During this troop lift much enemy fire was received. CHATTERBOX 6-8, flown by Capt R. HERBERG was forced to land at XD922289, after coming under heavy 50 caliber fire. The pilots and crew were safely picked up by 6-7 flown by Capt HAGER.
- 11 June 1968 MAJ H. C. BROWN inserted "Greek Money," a reconnaissance team at XD912244 under cover of two Seaworthy gunships. Although MAJ BROWN encountered small arms fire in his approach, the recon team was successfully inserted and no damage to the aircraft was sustained.
- 15 June 1968 One hour after being inserted, reconnaissance team "Amanda" requested an emergency extract, due to heavy enemy contact. Although CHATTERBOX 6-1, flown by MAJ BROWN received battle damage, the extract was completed with no injuries to the team or crew.
- 29 June 1968 While flying convoy escort between Khe Sanh and Stud, Capt. RICHARDS spotted a road block caused by a stuck vehicle. After a tank's attempt to free the vehicle failed, Capt RICHARDS and the crew chief, Cpl D. W. MARTIN agreed that they could apply enough lift to the vehicle to set it free. Due to ingenuity and quick thinking on the pilot's and crew chief's part, the convoy was able to continue on its way to Stud.

There was only one enemy initiated incident against Quang Tri Air Base this month. On the 22ND 12-15 rounds of 122mm rockets were fired at the airbase. Only one round landed at the airbase, landing at the light aircraft mat area. The majority of the rockets landed on the Marine Ground Forces, side of the base. There were 28 fire incidents resulting in 6 hits. All hits were received landing at LZ's: 4 of the hits were by SA, AW, .30/.50 cal fire; 2 by mortar/rocket fire.


